Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today is World Mission Sunday and the World Mission Collection. I would like to share with you excerpts from the Message of his Holiness Pope Francis for World Mission Sunday.

In this year marked by the suffering and challenges created by the COVID-19 pandemic, the missionary journey of the whole Church continues in light of the words found in the account of the calling of the prophet Isaiah: "Here am I, send me" (Isaiah 6:8) This is the ever new response to the Lord's question: "Whom should I send?" This invitation from God's merciful heart challenges both the Church and humanity as a whole in the current world crises.

Mission is a free and conscious response to God's call. Yet we discern this call only when we have a personal relationship of love with Jesus present in his Church. Let us ask ourselves: Are we prepared to welcome the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives, to listen to the call to mission? Are we willing to be sent forth at any time or place to witness to our faith in God the merciful Father, to proclaim the Gospel of salvation in Jesus Christ, to share the divine life of the Holy Spirit by building up the Church? Are we like Mary, the Mother of Jesus, ready to be completely at the service of God's will? (Luke 1:38)

The celebration of World Mission Sunday is also an occasion for reaffirming how prayer, reflection and the material help of your offerings are so many opportunities to participate actively in the mission of Jesus in his Church. The charity expressed in the collections that take place during the liturgical celebrations of the third Sunday of October is aimed at supporting the missionary work carried out in my name by the Pontifical Mission Societies, in order to meet the spiritual and material needs of peoples and Churches throughout the world, for the salvation of all.

May the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, Star of Evangelization and Comforter of the Afflicted, missionary disciple of her Son Jesus, continue to intercede for us and sustain us.

This year, the Church celebrates the 25th anniversary of the papal encyclical *Evangelium Vitae* (The Gospel of Life). This prophetic document was written by Pope Saint John Paul II to reaffirm the value and inviolability of every human life and to appeal to all people to respect, protect, love, and serve every human life. Let us pray fervently for an end to abortion, assisted suicide, racism, executions, and every other form of disrespect for human life.

PARISH MANAGER'S UPDATE

Once again, the COVID numbers as of October 13 will keep us at the current State tracking level for at least another two weeks. This means that we are still limited to 100 people in the church, so we will continue to have outdoor Masses—enjoying our beautiful southern California weather. Since we have less minutes of daylight every day, we are testing how quickly we can switch between outdoor and indoor Masses.

You may have noticed that our HOPE Office has replaced one of their two large storage bins with a new bin. The old bins have seen better days so they need to be replaced. A temporary bin is providing storage during this transition. The second bin should be installed on October 24.

Just a quick safety note. When you exit the parking lot onto Springdale Street, especially when traffic is relatively heavy, please make a right turn out of the parking lot. I know it might take you a few more minutes to get to your destination, but avoiding a car accident is worth the time.

We will walk in community through the mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary, guided by the meditations given to us in this book.

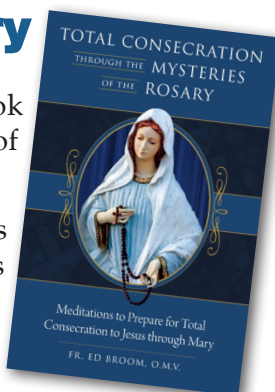
