Pastor's corner



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today is the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord as related in the second chapter of the Gospel according to St. Matthew. The Magi (Wise Men) from the East enter Jerusalem and offer congratulations in honor of the birth of the new king of the Jews. They announce, "We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage."

However, when King Herod heard this announcement, "He was greatly troubled and all of Jerusalem with him." Where was this usurper to his throne? He must be eliminated. The chief priests and scribes quote from the fifth chapter of the Book of the Prophet Micah, "And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel." King David came from Bethlehem so presumably this is where the Messiah would come from. The Magi go to Bethlehem guided by the star and encounter the child Jesus with his mother Mary. They offer him gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Gifts fit for the newborn king. The Magi are warned in a dream not to go back to Herod. (Matthew 2:1-12)

Epiphany means "manifestation." Jesus manifests himself to these Gentiles. He shows himself to these non-Jewish astrologers. God invites all to come see and know his Son. In the Liturgy of the Hours that is prayed by priests, religious, and many lay Catholics, the antiphon before the Cantic of Mary on the Solemnity of Epiphany declares the following, "Three mysteries mark this holy day: today the star leads the Magi to the infant Christ; today water is changed into wine for the wedding feast; today Christ wills to be baptized by John in the river Jordan to bring us salvation." Each of these was a manifestation of the Glory of the Lord.

Some of the ways our Lord Jesus Christ manifests himself is in the Sacraments of the Church. When we were baptized our Lord manifested himself through water and the Holy Spirit washing away our sins. During the Mass Jesus manifests himself in the bread and wine becoming his Body and Blood. In the Sacrament of Penance Jesus manifests his forgiveness. In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick Jesus manifests his healing. In the Sacrament of Matrimony Jesus manifests his love. These are just a few of the many ways our Lord shows himself to us.

During this New Year may our Lord Jesus Christ manifest his Glory in many wonderful and mysterious ways, "Upon you the Lord shines, and over you appears his glory" (Isaiah 60:2).

10 Minutes a Day for Prayer

The St. Bonaventure Parish Council and the Stewardship Ministry are starting a 2021 campaign called, "10 Minutes a Day for Prayer." We would like to see every parishioner join us! This campaign starts now and will run through Easter.

To do 10 minutes a day of prayer, pick a given time of day and a given quiet place.

It takes about 10 minutes to say the rosary or just speak with God, Mary, or the Saints. Make it your time with God. You can also use the following *Prayer Process* from Matthew Kelly's book, *I Heard God Laugh*.



STEP 1 GRATITUDE

Begin by thanking God in a personal dialogue for whatever you are most grateful for today.

STEP 2 AWARENESS

Revisit the times in the past 24 hours when you were and were not the-best-version-of-yourself. Talk to God about these situations and what you learned from them.

STEP 3 SIGNIFICANT MOMENTS

Identify something you experienced in the past 24 hours and explore what God might be trying to say to you through that event (or person).

STEP 4 PEACE

Ask God to forgive you for any wrong you have committed (against yourself, another person, or Him) and to fill you with a deep and abiding peace.

STEP 5 FREEDOM

Speak with God about how He is inviting you to change your life so that you can experience the freedom to be the-best-version-of-yourself.

STEP 6 OTHERS

Lift up to God anyone you feel called to pray for today, asking God to bless and guide them.

STEP 7 PRAY THE OUR FATHER

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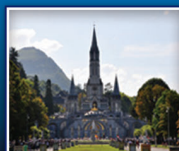
