Pastor's corner



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

Welcome to the First Sunday of Lent. In the Gospel reading today from the first chapter of St. Mark, Jesus tells us, "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."

In the First Reading from chapter nine of the Book of Genesis, God tells us, "When I bring clouds over the earth, and the bow appears in the clouds, I will recall the covenant I have made between me and you and all living beings, so that the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all mortal beings."

In the third chapter of the First Letter of St. Peter, we are told that those human beings in the Ark, "were saved through water." This prefigured baptism which saves us now. "It is not a removal of dirt from the body but an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God."

For many of us, we were baptized when we were infants. Baptism is the first Sacrament that we received. However, it was not just a one day's occurrence. Baptism is the beginning of our life in the Lord. We are washed clean of Original Sin and become children of God. What we receive at baptism remains with us through out our lives. It opens the door to eternal life for us.

This Sunday at the 5:00 p.m. Mass, adults and children will go through the Rite of Election. These catechumens include children and adults. They have been preparing for the Sacrament of Baptism as well as Confirmation and Holy Eucharist for two years. And now they will complete their period of preparation during Lent and be chosen (elected) to participate in the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist this Easter. The Rite of Election is typically done at the Cathedral before the Bishop. However, the Bishop this year, because of COVID concerns, has given permission to pastors, to have this Rite in each of our parish churches.

Please keep these catechumens in your prayer. Please also pray that the Lord Jesus Christ will renew our faith, free us from our sins, and prepare us to celebrate the great Feasts honoring the Passion of the Lord, his Resurrection from the Dead, and his Ascension to the right hand of the Father.

Parish Manager's update

Overall, our first Sunday back inside our church went fairly well. Most people went into the church for Mass but about 10% stayed out on the plaza. We didn't really need the hall for seating but it was ready. For next weekend we will likely repeat the process from this past weekend. Thanks again to our volunteers who helped prepare the hall and the plaza.

One issue with having seating on the plaza and in the hall is that every weekend Mass has to be livestreamed. Otherwise, the TV screen on the plaza will be blank. So our tech team, instead of operating outdoor cameras, is learning to operate the indoor, remotely controlled cameras. So now you know why we had to livestream all Masses last weekend. Once everyone can be seated inside the church, then we can reduce our schedule of streamed Masses.

Due to the U.S. Supreme Court case I mentioned in last week's bulletin, I think we'll be staying in our church for many years to come. I think our only risk, as will all other houses of worship in California, is if churches experience an outbreak of COVID. If that happens, Church leaders in California, such as our Bishop Vann, may decide to close indoor churches for the common good. That's why we need to reduce our risk of COVID by continuing to follow COVID guidelines for physical distancing, mask wearing and cleaning protocols.

Regarding physical distancing, some have suggested that we implement a reservation system for seating. We prefer to let you be responsible for maintaining physical distancing. Remember, if the church is full, you can still sit outside or in the hall. Regarding masks, we'll continue to have them available for those who forgot to bring their mask. And for cleaning protocols, we need your help to clean our pews and plastic chairs after all Masses. We really need some more volunteers to help with this activity.

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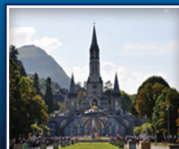
