Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Lent. It is also known as Laetare Sunday. Laetare is a Latin word which means "Rejoice." We are rejoicing because in less than three weeks we will be celebrating

the great feasts honoring the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

In the Gospel according to John, chapter three, Jesus told the Pharisee Nicodemus, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. ... And this is the verdict, that the light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed. Parish Manager's update

As I mentioned last week, we received permission from the Diocese to hire our own roofer to repair the leak in our church roof. The same week, we had a roofer examine our roof and we believe he has correctly diagnosed the root cause of our roof leak. In less than a week, we have a priced proposal for the repair. The even better news is that we won't have to pay the cost!

The not-so-good news is that the cause of the leak exists in other areas of the roof. The root cause appears to be located where the roofing meets concrete walls of the church. We actually have this connection in multiple areas of our church. In fact, the front wall near the choir area also has a small leak that we want to repair at the same time as the other, more significant repair. Hopefully the repairs can be scheduled as soon as we have a few days of dry weather.

If the church appears to be fairly full during Sunday Masses, it might be because it is full! Last week we had our second highest attendance since the start of the pandemic. The only higher attendance was a few weeks earlier when we had our confirmation students at the Sunday evening Mass. As a reminder, we plan to open the plaza and the hall for all weekend Masses. And please note that the 5:00 p.m. Sunday Mass on March 21 will be entirely outside on the plaza, weather permitting, because of the large number of parishioners attending with their confirmation students. Again, this is only for the 5:00 p.m. Sunday Mass on March 21. All other Masses that weekend will be indoors.

Thank you for all your donations to the Building Fund. We are working with the Finance Council to give you a monthly financial update on our Building Fund. We need something that is quick and easy to generate while providing useful information to our parish.

- Pick up food once a week from Albertsons or Trader Joe's (approximately 1-1.5 hours, must have a large car or truck, be able to lift 20lbs).

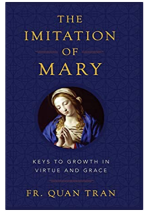

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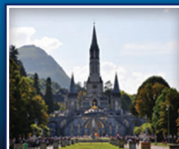
