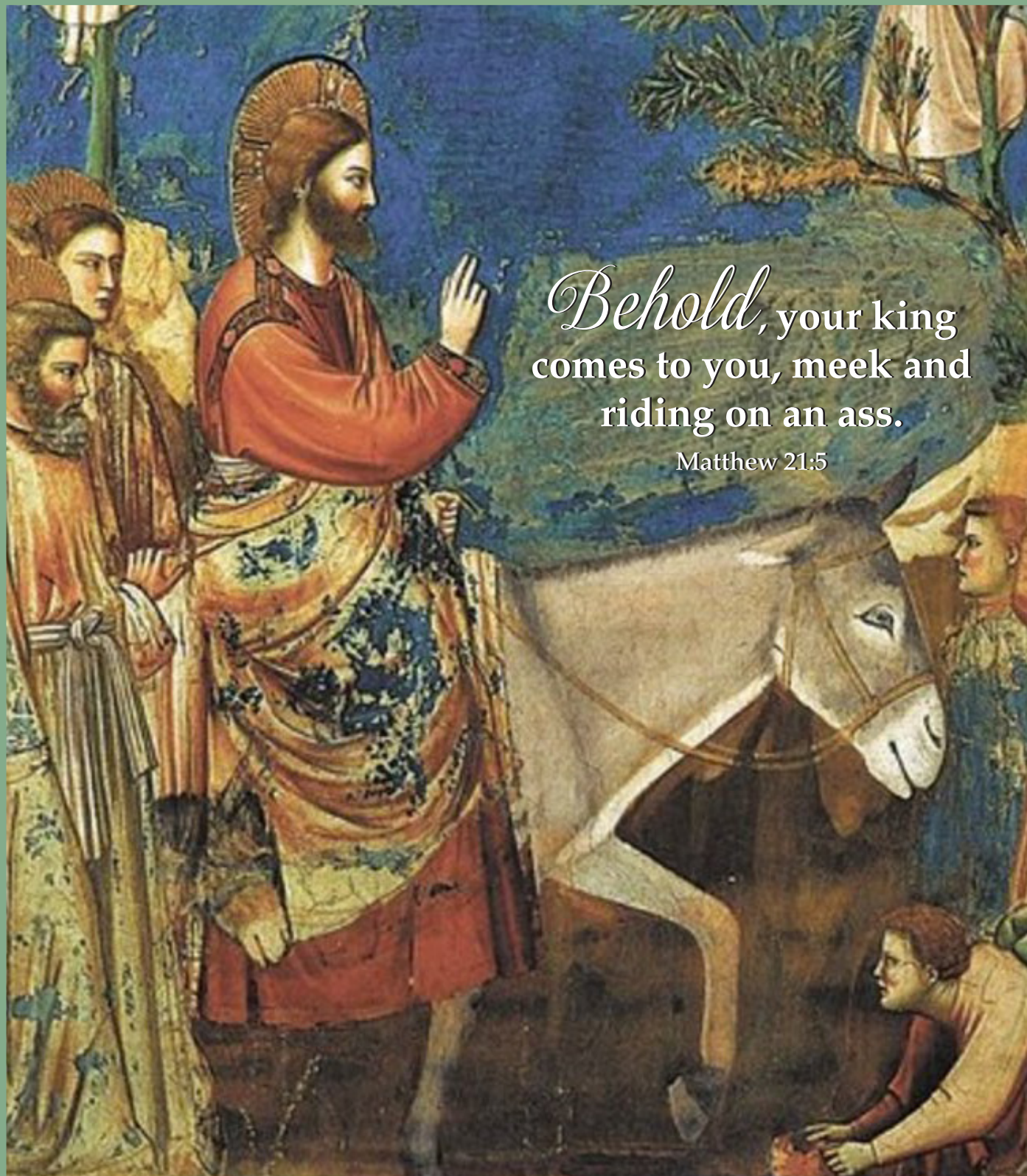

Pastor's corner



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Holy Week begins today with Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion. The same people who are singing the praises of Jesus in the Gospel passage at the beginning of today's Mass, "Hosanna! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to come!

Hosanna in the highest!", will be yelling, "Crucify him," by the time we get to the Gospel passage during the Liturgy of the Word. Today's Holy Scripture Readings give us a glimpse of the Holy Scripture Readings at the end of this week.

I hope you can join us for the Liturgies on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil/Sunday. In essence, these three days join in what is called the Sacred Paschal Triduum. Yes, we let you go home at night to sleep; however, you will notice that at the end of Holy Thursday and Good Friday there is no "Sign of the Cross" Blessing. This is not given until the end of the Vigil and Easter Day Masses.

Holy Thursday helps us honor the first Mass of the Last Supper, which includes the washing of the disciples' feet. Good Friday helps us honor the suffering and death of our Lord on the Cross, "The soldiers crucified Jesus and ... he gave a loud cry and breathed his last" (John 18:1-19:42). Easter Vigil and Sunday honor the resurrection of our Lord from the dead, "On entering the tomb they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a white robe, and they were utterly amazed. He said to them, 'Do not be amazed! You seek Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Behold the place where they laid him. But go and tell his disciples and Peter, He is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him, as he told you'" (Mark 16:1-7).

Please see the times for these Liturgies in this bulletin. If you have not yet gone to Confession, the last available times before Easter will be this Tuesday, March 30. There will not be Confessions on Saturday, April 3.

St. Paul wrote in his Letter to the Romans, "Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life" (Romans 6:3-4).

Please pray for those receiving Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Together may we continue to grow in Faith, Hope, and Love.

Parish Manager's update

Some parishioners have asked me if moving from the purple tier to the red tier to the orange tier will result in any changes at our parish. The short answer is "no." Available seating inside our church is primarily restricted by the requirement that we maintain six feet social distancing. Even if we are permitted to have 900 people in our church, the requirement for six feet social distancing will keep available seating to where it is today, more or less. I have heard rumors of reducing the social distancing requirement, but only for schools.

On a related note, please remember that the Hall is available for overflow seating during our weekend Masses. We turned the chairs to face west so we can use a higher resolution projector, so now the text on the screen is much sharper. Also, Eucharistic Ministers do bring Holy Communion to the Hall. I know the weather will start to get warmer, since Spring has arrived, but we've been having winds that have limited the use of canopies on the plaza.

Also, I noticed that many of you must be forgetting your masks at home. We are buying several boxes of masks every week, along with gloves, sanitizers, etc. We don't mind providing masks, since they are a requirement from the diocese for reopening our church. Some parishes in our diocese are still having weekend Masses outdoors. Since we are closer to the coast, we want to have most of our Masses indoors. Now I just have to find some masks that are labeled, "I stole this mask from St. Bonaventure Church!"

Finally, if you received a PSA appeal letter a few weeks ago—even though you are already contributing to PSA—don't worry! It's a long story, but everything should be OK. The letter should have mentioned that some people are already contributing to PSA.

Thanks, everyone, for your patience over the past 12 months of COVID and the many months of construction that preceded COVID. —Charles Falzon, Parish Manager

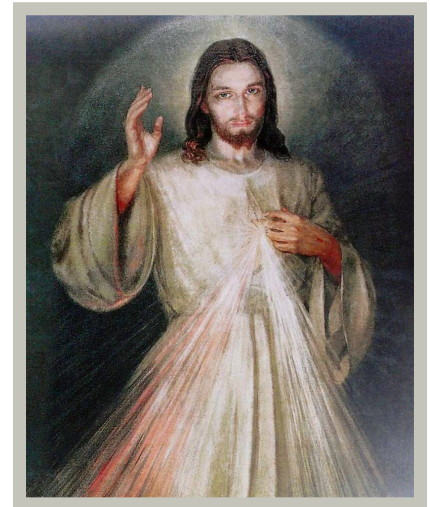
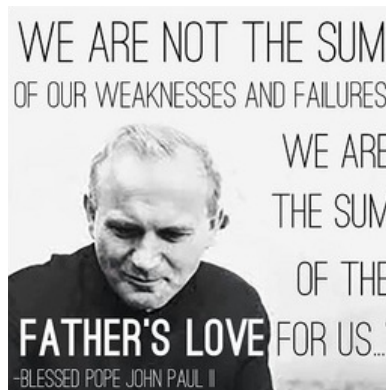

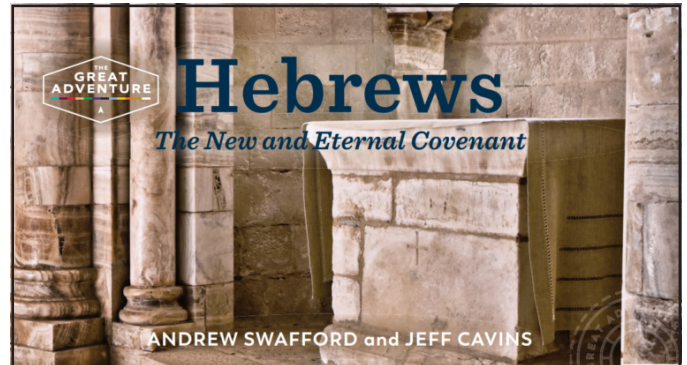

LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS

For those with gluten intolerance, St. Bonaventure offers low-gluten hosts. In order to avail of these special hosts, notify the priest by going into the Vestry a minimum of ten minutes before Mass starts. Since even trace amounts of gluten can be harmful to those with this sensitivity, it is important to be mindful of "cross-contamination" with our usual hosts. To avoid "cross-contamination," it is best for the communicant to prepare a pyx (a small round container used to carry the host) with the low-gluten host before Mass.



Low-gluten hosts are stored in the Sacristy, which is located behind the Altar. Inside the Sacristy, in the first cabinet to your left upon entering there is a small plastic container labeled "low-gluten host and pyx." Place the low-gluten host in the pyx provided, then place the pyx on the altar to be consecrated at Mass. At Communion time, be the first to approach the priest who will have the consecrated host in the pyx. Receive the pyx from the celebrant. Please be sure to clean and return the pyx to the Sacristy Cabinet for others to use. *For more info please check with the Sacristan in charge of your Mass.*
