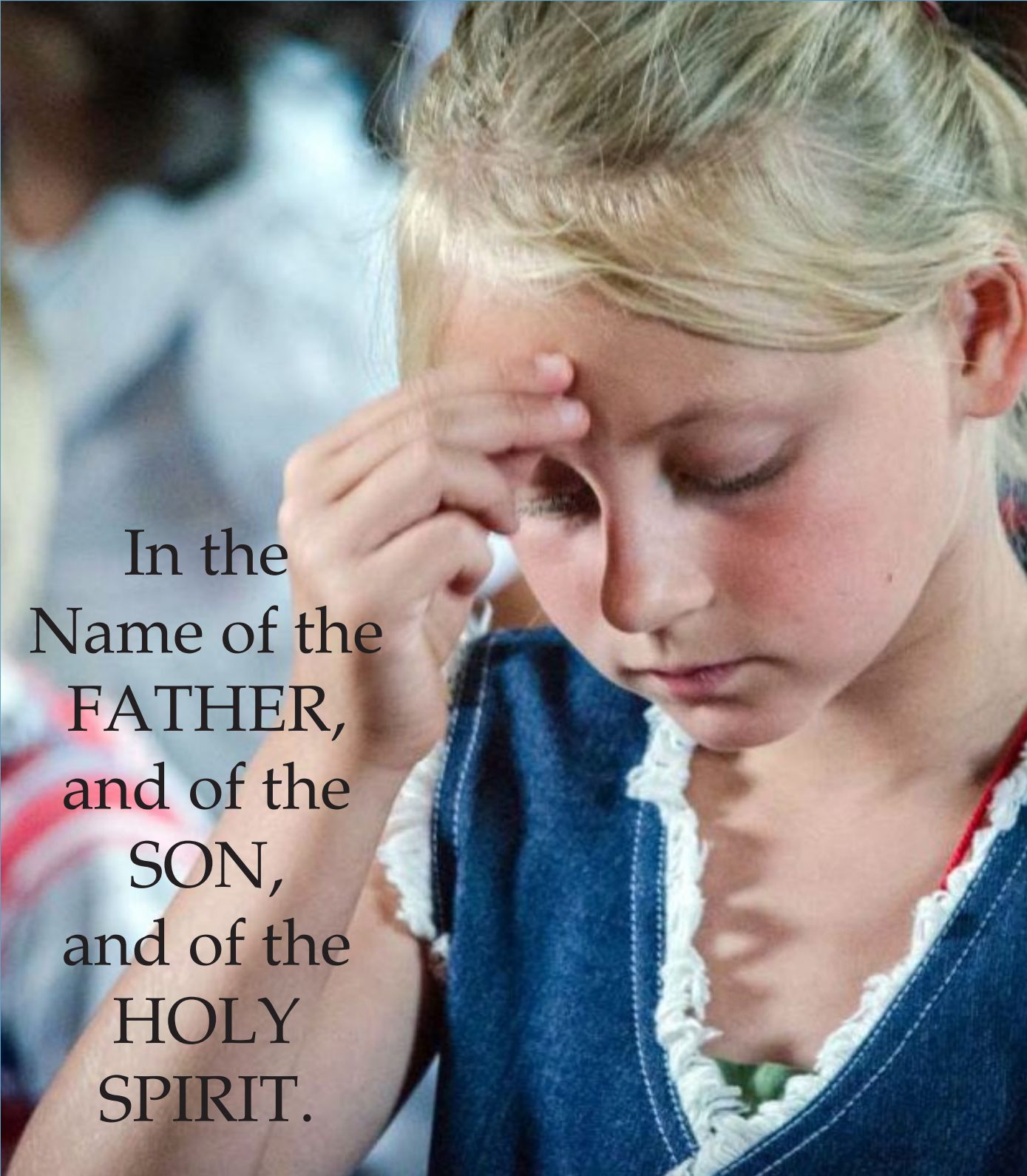

Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Gospel account today comes at the conclusion of the Gospel according to St. Matthew:

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted. Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28:16-20).

As Jesus was about to ascend to the right hand of the Father, he gave his most important pronouncement. Jesus Christ, who has all power in heaven and on earth, sent his disciples to baptize in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. The disciples must teach the newly baptized to observe all that he had commanded. He assured them that he would always be with them until the end of the age.

Jesus, the Son of God, wanted us to know that God is One and that God is Trinity. Theologians have pondered this mystery since Jesus first made this pronouncement. Every Catholic family should have a copy of the Bible and read it daily. I would also request that you have a copy of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* which was promulgated by Pope Saint John Paul II. You can learn more about our belief in the Holy Trinity in numbers 232 through 260. There is not room in this letter to delve into the entirety of this great mystery. Let me concentrate on numbers 242 through 244:

The Church confessed at the first ecumenical council at Nicaea (325) that the Son is "consubstantial" with the Father, that is, one only God with him. The second ecumenical council, held at Constantinople in 381, kept this expression in its formulation of the Nicene Creed and confessed "the only-begotten Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, light from light, true God from true God, begotten not made, consubstantial with the Father." (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, number 242) Before his Passover, Jesus announced the sending of "another Paraclete" (Advocate), the Holy Spirit. At work since creation, having previously "spoken through the prophets," the Spirit will now be with and in the disciples, to teach them and guide them "into all the truth." The Holy Spirit is thus revealed as another divine person with Jesus and the Father. (CCC, number 243) The sending of the person of the Spirit after Jesus' glorification reveals in its fullness the mystery of the Holy Trinity. (CCC, number 244)

It is therefore appropriate that the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity is celebrated on the Sunday after Pentecost. We profess every Sunday:

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God. ... I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. ... (excerpts from the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed)

Next time you make the Sign of the Cross, realize you are praying to our One God in Three Persons. You are embracing God as He embraces you: "In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

Parish Manager's update

We are working to schedule a number of projects for both the church and school over the summer. With few repairs performed last summer due to COVID, we have a significant list for this year, as funding permits. Projects are either funded by our church operating fund (not our building fund), or by the school, or by both the church and school sharing costs. Most projects must wait to start until school ends on June 17 and then be completed before school starts on August 23. This gives us about 45 weekdays to complete most of our projects.

We hope to repair fascia board in multiple locations, reroof the convent (starting to fail--has it ever been reroofed?), asphalt repairs in our parking lot (safety hazards), resurface and restripe our parking lot (well overdue), repaint the outside of the hall and rectory, replace the playground equipment (16 years old and failing), and install a secondary safety fence for the school. The need for the fence was identified in 2000, and a Diocesan Schools Sustainability Task Force in 2018 reiterated the "immediate" need for the fence.

The fence will be installed in such a way as to protect students, teachers and staff starting from the "big field" near Heil and extending to the basketball courts near Orlando, roughly following the red plastic cones that have been providing daily protection for our students. The fence will be very similar to the fence we installed around the hall, using the same firm that Sts. Simon & Jude Church used. Most diocesan schools (if not all) and most local public schools already have some type of secondary safety fence. Our fence will have 8 sets of 12-foot wide gates (24' per opening) that will be closed during the school day and opened on the weekends.

Work on the parking lot and the fence will potentially have some impact on parishioners. Both must be jointly scheduled. Once the posts are installed for the fence, then the parking lot will be resurfaced and restriped—all 130,000+ sq. ft. of asphalt—over about 3-4 days. Then the fence sections and gates will be installed over a two-week period. All the while, the other projects and summer activities will be working around the fence/parking lot schedule.

Again, no Building Fund donations will be used on these projects. Your Building Fund donations are only used to pay down our loan from the diocese.

Thank you for making these projects possible.

Father Jenkins' vocation as a Holy Cross priest is grounded in being a teacher of our Catholic faith. The rich tradition of the Holy Cross as educators and influencers is well understood.

"The beauty of a Catholic, diocesan high school is that it represents the local Body of Christ in its racial, ethnic and socioeconomic diversity," Father Jenkins said. "I have that feeling about Mater Dei. I'm excited about joining such a wonderful community of faith and learning."

Father Jenkins holds a bachelor's degree in government from King's College. He received his Master of Divinity from the University of Notre Dame and his doctorate in Catholic school leadership from the University of San Francisco.

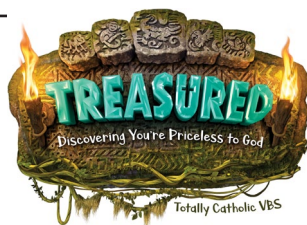

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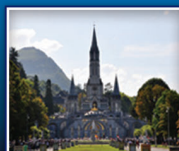
