

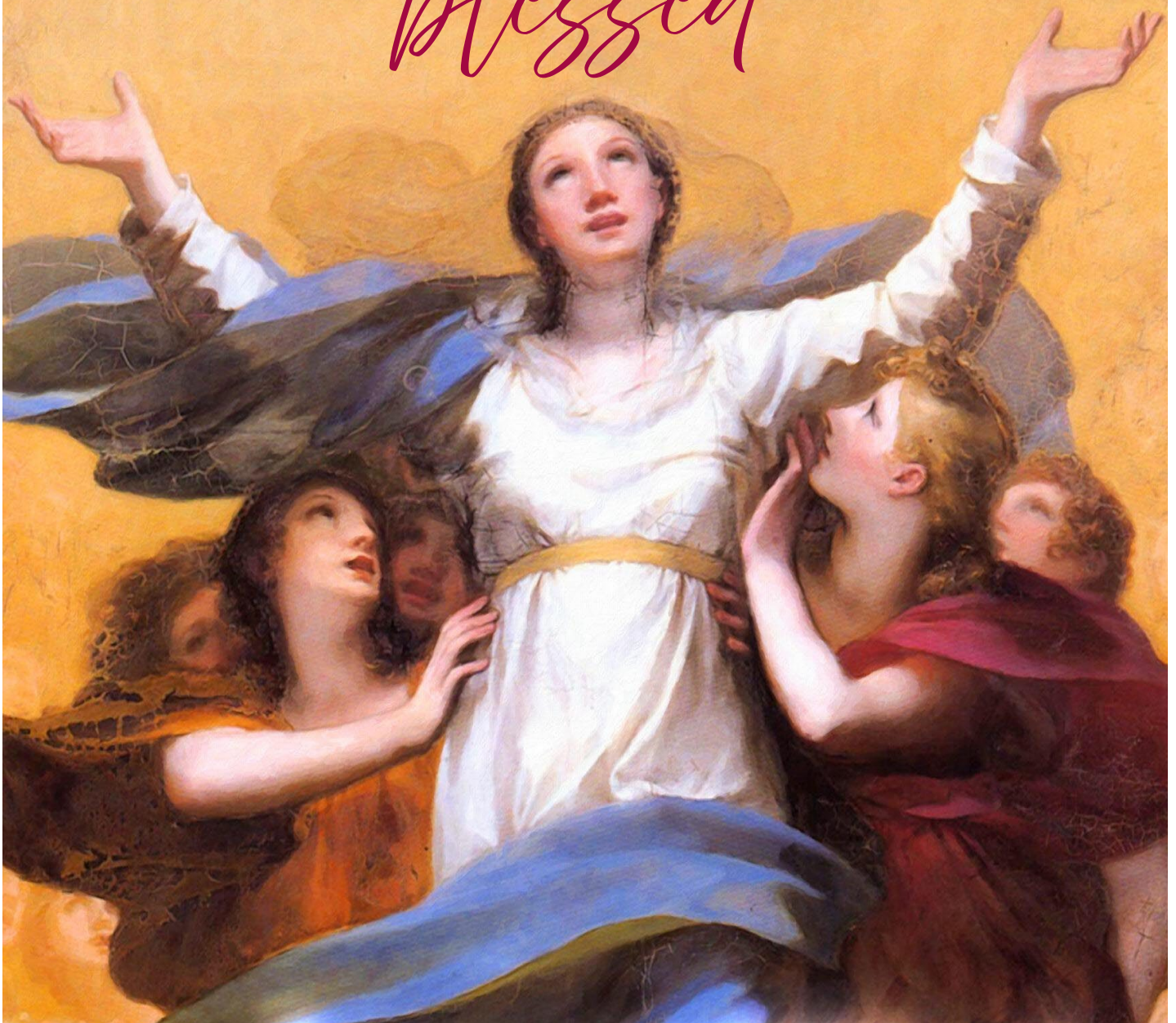

Pastor's corner

On this Solemnity in honor of the Assumption of Mary into heaven, I would like to share with you a portion of the Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus* by Pope Pius XII which established this as a dogma of the Catholic Church's Faith:

In their homilies and sermons on this feast the holy fathers and great doctors spoke of the assumption of the Mother of God as something already familiar and accepted by the faithful. They gave it greater clarity in their preaching and used more profound arguments in setting out its nature and meaning. Above all, they brought out more clearly the fact that what is commemorated in this feast is not simply the total absence of corruption from the dead body of the Blessed Virgin Mary but also her triumph over death and her glorification in heaven, after the pattern set by her only Son, Jesus Christ.

Thus Saint John Damascene, preeminent as the great preacher of this truth of tradition, speaks with powerful eloquence when he relates the bodily assumption of the loving Mother of God to her other gifts and privileges: "It was necessary that she who had preserved her virginity inviolate in childbirth should also have her body kept free from all corruption after death. It was necessary that she who had carried the Creator as a child on her breast should dwell in the tabernacles of God. It was necessary that the bride espoused by the Father should make her home in the bridal chambers of heaven. It was necessary that she, who had gazed on her crucified Son and been pierced in the heart by the sword of sorrow which she had escaped in giving him birth, should contemplate him seated with the Father. It was necessary that the Mother of God should share the possessions of her Son, and be venerated by every creature as the Mother and handmaid of God."

Hence, the august Mother of God, mysteriously united from all eternity with Jesus Christ in one and the same decree of predestination, immaculate in her conception, a virgin inviolate in her divine motherhood, the whole-hearted companion of the divine Redeemer who won complete victory over sin and its consequences, gained at last the supreme crown of her privilege—to be preserved immune from the corruption of the tomb, and, like her Son, when death had been conquered, to be carried up body and soul to the exalted glory of heaven, there to sit in splendor at the right hand of her Son, the immortal King of the ages.

O Blessed Mother, we turn to you in our sorrow and our joy. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Parish Manager's update

This coming week, if the schedule holds, the leaking glass in the skylight above the tapestry will be replaced. Starting after the morning Mass on Monday, the nave of the church will likely be closed to allow for this work. The Blessed Sacrament Chapel will be open. It will take several days to complete but weekday morning Masses will not be impacted. The new glass is a 1" thick laminated glass. It is actually several layers of glass and spacers resulting in an insulated, laminated, tempered glass. I have a 12" square sample that weighs nearly 7 lbs. You will still see sunlight coming in through the skylight, but it will be diffused light to help protect our new tapestry. Many thanks to the anonymous donor who is funding this replacement.

The gates for the fence are just starting to arrive. Although the gates are similar, they are all individually manufactured. Some gates will roll and some are hinged. With the August 23rd start of the school year, the fence company is trying to get all the gates installed as soon as they are available. Once they are installed, we will add some reflective safety tape to make the fence more visible after dark, and we'll have to add some signs as required by the City. In general, the gates will be open on the weekends and closed during the school day.

As a reminder, with the new secondary safety fence, some of our parking spaces are now 10' wide instead of the standard 9' width. You can usually find about 4 or 5 of these spaces when a row of parking stalls is parallel to the new fence. In total we have about 40 of these wider spaces.

Several warranty repairs were completed at the church this past week, most of which are not in the nave of the church so you won't notice them. We are still discussing repairs to our drywall ceiling. There are several small cracks in the ceiling that you can't see when the lights are turned on. Don't worry, the church ceiling is not going anywhere—unless my older brother comes to church—but we would like the cracks to be repaired under warranty. One drywall estimate wants 7 weekdays to repair and paint the ceiling. We are working to get other estimates.

Other repair and repainting projects made progress this week including the repainting of the hall and the rectory. Again, nothing mentioned above was funded by our Building Fund. Donations to the Building Fund go toward repaying our loan. Thank you for your continued generosity.

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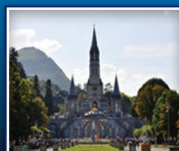
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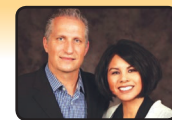
