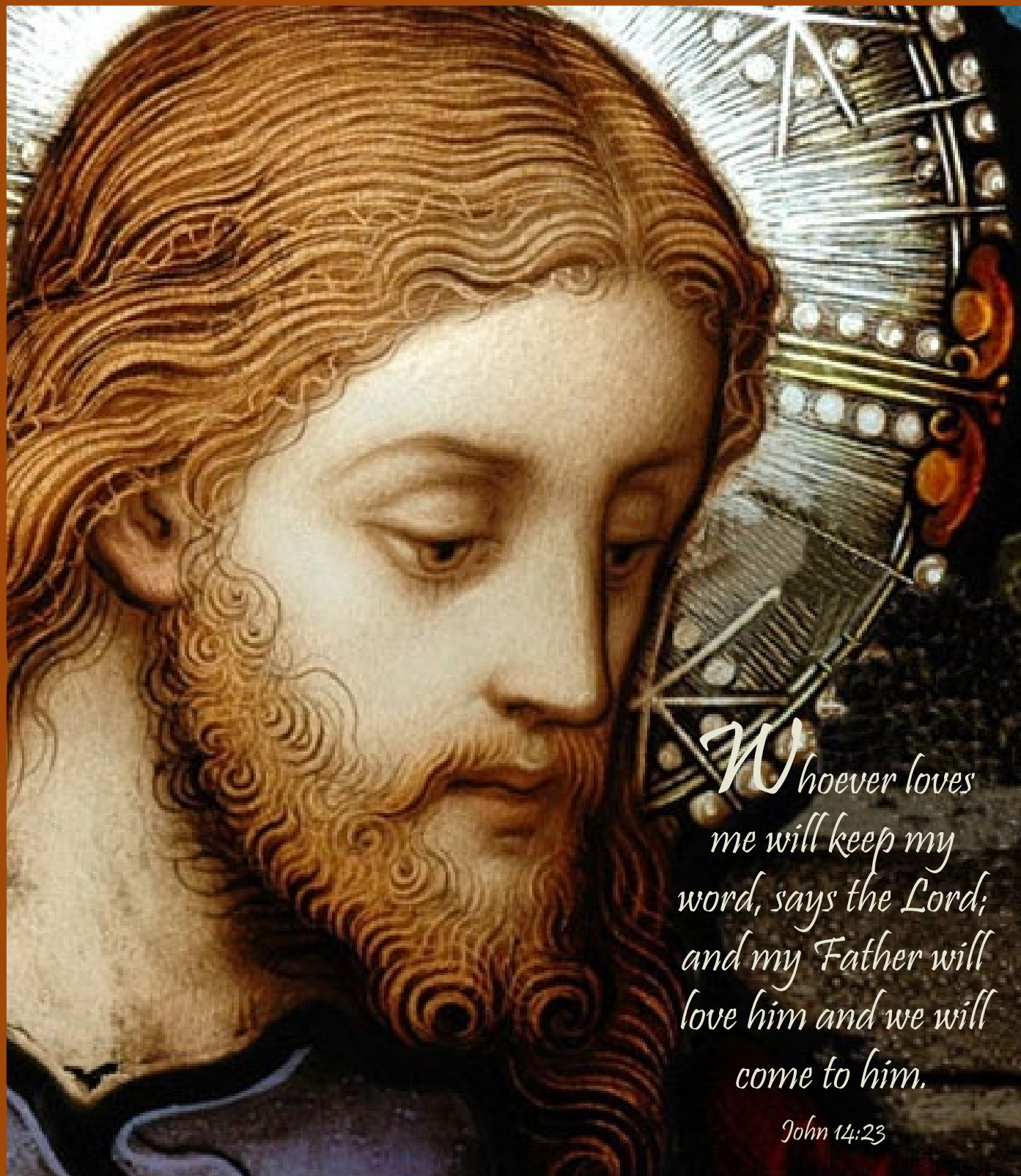

Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday the First Reading is from the Book of Deuteronomy 6:2-6. It includes the Hebrew pronouncement of God delivered by Moses: *shema yisra'el*, "Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone..." In the Gospel Reading today (Mark 12:28-34) one of the scribes asked Jesus which is the first of all the commandments. Jesus replied with the Shema, "Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength." Jesus continued with the commandment which comes from the Book of Leviticus 19:18, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Jesus then pronounced, "There is no other commandment greater than these."

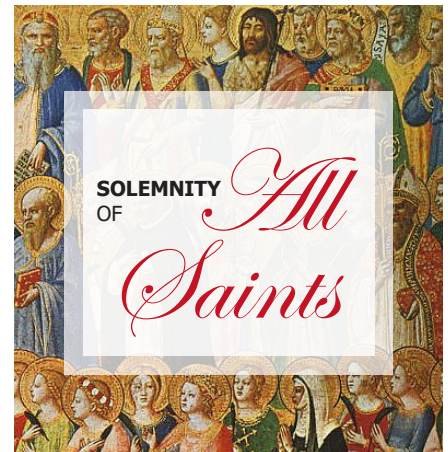
We do everything possible to show our love for God. We worship only the one true God and we do not allow anyone or anything to take the place of God. We do not take his name in vain. We honor his name; we pray to him. We participate in Sunday Mass, the Holy Eucharist, the height, depth and summit of our prayers to God through, with, and in his Son, Jesus Christ.

When it comes to loving our neighbor? This is sometimes challenging. We get into arguments with our loved ones and then find it hard to ask for forgiveness. We get jealous and envious. We want what they have. All the more reason to pray to God, asking him to help us to truly love our neighbor, to truly forgive him and ask for forgiveness. It is good to be honest with the Lord and pray, "Lord, my neighbor, has really hurt me. Without your help I cannot forgive him. Lord, I have deeply hurt my neighbor, without your help I find it hard to ask for forgiveness. Help me, Lord! Help me remember all the times you have forgiven me. Help me to do the same."

Remember, loving your neighbor as yourself is not a bonus commandment. It is our way of showing our love for God. St. John said it well in his First Letter, "Whoever loves his brother remains in the light, and there is nothing in him to cause a fall. Whoever hates his brother is in darkness; he walks in darkness and does not know where he is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes." (1 John 2:10-11) St. John also wrote, "If anyone says, 'I love God', but hates his brother, he is a liar; for whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen." (1 John 4:20)

At Mass today, keep this in mind as you sing the Alleluia verse: "Whoever loves me will keep my word, says the Lord; and my Father will love him and we will come to him" (John 14:23).

La nueva alianza es Cristo mismo, el nuevo Israel es la Iglesia. Una vez más, Dios toma la iniciativa y se hace uno de nosotros, plenamente. La participación mutua de Dios no puede ser mayor, pues se hace uno de nosotros y habita entre nosotros. Las categorías se rompen totalmente, no hay deberes nuestros para con Cristo, hay respuesta a una invitación concreta: coman y beban, hagan esto en memoria mía. Jesús mismo instituye, en el contexto de una cena, una nueva alianza. Cristo, al derramar su sangre, corta su propio cuerpo para sellar, mediante él, mediante su sangre, la nueva alianza. Al beber su sangre nos hacemos uno con él, porque él ya se hizo uno con nosotros. La alianza no es en un animal sacrificado, sino en él mismo, que se hace cordero para el sacrificio. 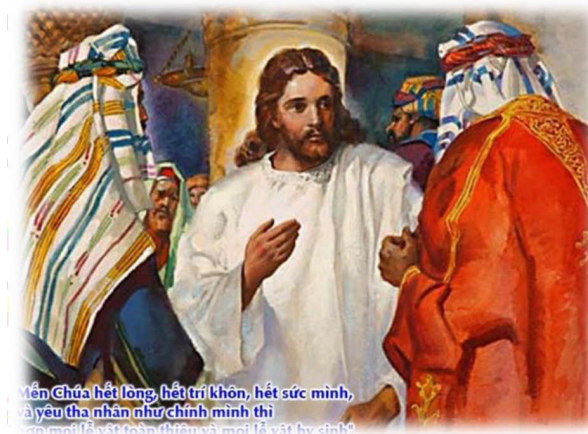

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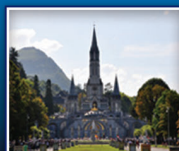
