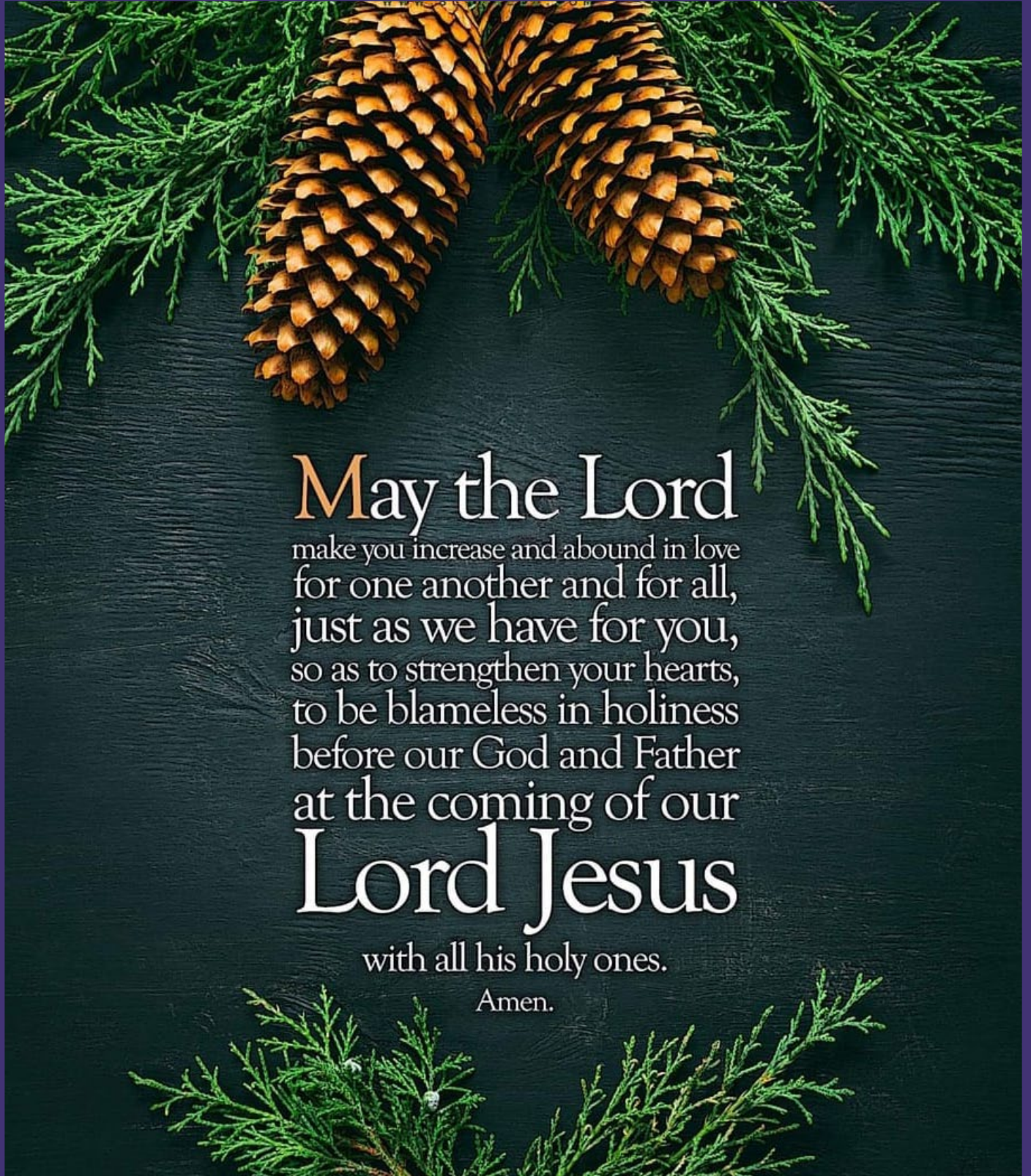

Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Season of Advent has begun. We are preparing for the coming of our Lord on Christmas. We are also preparing for the second coming of our Lord. His first coming was in a stable in Bethlehem, the angel announced to the shepherds, "I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find an infant wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger" (Luke 2:10-12). In his second coming, "There will be signs in the sun, the moon, and the stars, and on earth nations will be in dismay ... for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand" (Luke 21:25-28).

As we prepare to celebrate the first coming of Jesus at Christmas, let us also prepare ourselves for his second coming. How do we prepare for his second coming? Listen to what our Lord Jesus Christ said, "Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy from carousing and drunkenness and the anxieties of daily life, and that day catch you by surprise like a trap. For that day will assault everyone who lives on the face of the earth. Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations that are imminent and to stand before the Son of Man" (Luke 21:34-36).

St. Paul advised us in his First Letter to the Thessalonians, "May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, just as we have for you, so as to strengthen your hearts, to be blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his holy ones. Amen" (1 Thessalonians 3:12-13).

Be vigilant! Be hopeful! Be open to conversion of heart! Be ready for the coming of our Lord!



Parish Manager's update

As I mentioned last week, we have created a web-based survey where you can provide your comments regarding our festival earlier this month. This will help us plan the festival for next year. What did you like about the festival? What could have been done better? Please take a few minutes to complete the survey. The link to the survey is on the right side of this page.

One more festival "thank you" to Redeemer Lutheran Church, across the street from our church, for allowing our festival attendees to park in their parking lot. Pastor Jim Toma at RLC and his parishioners have always been very understanding of our festival parking situation.

There are some repairs that we have recently completed and others that are planned. Sometimes something small can have a big impact. For example, the lock for the tabernacle was becoming difficult for our sacristans to unlock. Obviously, we need to be able to lock and unlock the tabernacle. Fortunately, this was a quick, inexpensive repair. On the larger side is the leaking skylight at the convent. While most of us would like some rain, our Presentation Sisters, for some reason, want to keep the rain on the outside of the convent. I thought the leaking rain water would remind them of the rain in Ireland! The new skylight will be similar to the new skylight in the church. We hope to schedule this replacement in early December. (I love you, Sisters!)

The Building Fund update for October 31st should be in next week's bulletin, along with our annual financial report to the parish. The festival delayed the closing of our books for October but we should be ready for next week.

Wasn't the festival weather wonderful, especially in the evenings? Father Joe was praying for good weather. When I saw the forecast for temperatures in the high 80's (we reached 93 degrees), I asked Fr. Joe to pull back on his prayers. By Sunday the temperatures were great. Thanks, Fr. Joe! And thanks again to all of you who supported our festival. I hope to have some festival financial results soon.

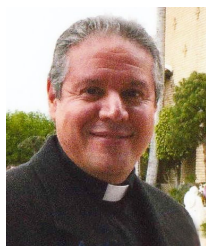

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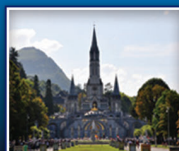
