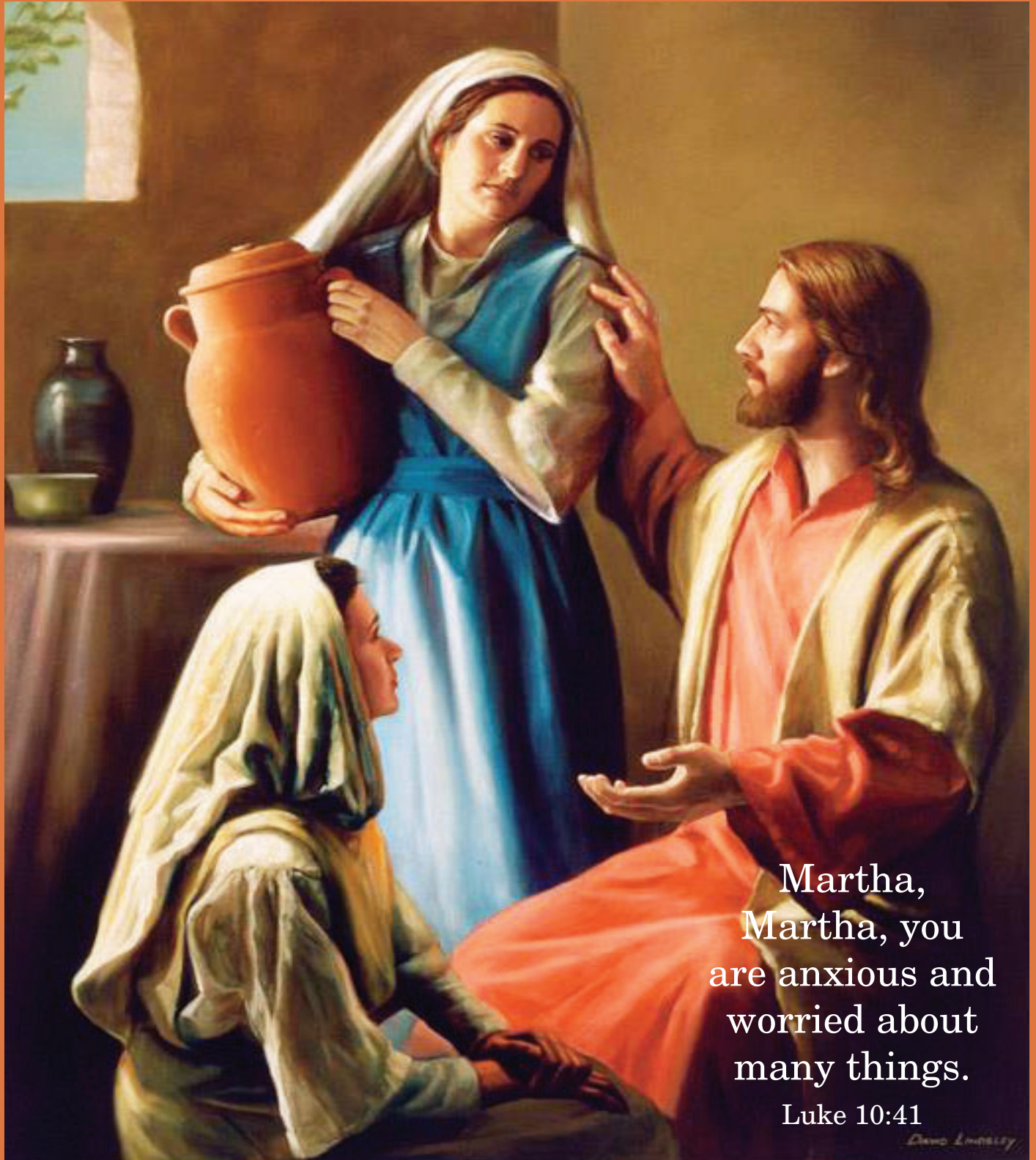

Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Let's look at the Scripture Readings for this Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The First Reading is from chapter 18 of the Book of Genesis. As Abraham was sitting at the entrance to his tent, three travelers show up. Abraham extended Middle Eastern hospitality to them. He invited them to have their feet washed from their dusty journey. Then he asked them to stay for a meal. Notice that the Scriptural account fluctuates between Abraham addressing all three men and then only addressing one. The early Church interpreted this as a reference to the Holy Trinity, One God in Three Persons.

The Gospel Reading today is from the tenth chapter of the Gospel according to Luke. Again, we encounter a wonderful example of Middle Eastern hospitality. Martha invited Jesus into the home she shared with her sister, Mary. As Martha prepared a meal for their guest, Mary "sat beside the Lord at his feet listening to him speak" (Luke 10:39). Martha got upset that Mary wasn't helping her with serving the meal. She told Jesus to intervene and tell Mary to help her. Instead, Jesus told Martha that Mary, "had chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her" (Luke 10:42).

How do we give hospitality to God? Are we like Martha, that is, "burdened with many things?" Or are we sitting beside the Lord at his feet listening to him?

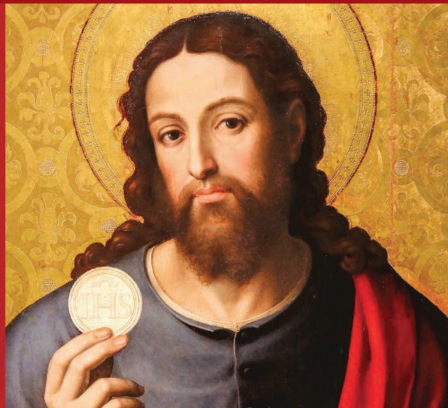
There is a place for both servant-oriented Martha and contemplation-oriented Mary in our time with our Lord Jesus. Our Lord enjoyed a good meal. However, what he was eating wasn't as important as the people he was with. Sometimes they were Pharisees and scribes attempting to find fault with the message of Jesus. Our Lord wanted to soften their hard hearts. Sometimes they were tax collectors and sinners who needed the healing forgiveness of Jesus to fill them with new and abundant life.

And then there was that meal that changed everything. Jesus took bread, pronounced the blessing, and said, "This is my Body; This is my Blood." Our Lord offered the greatest hospitality. He offered himself to his closest disciples. Every time we have the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, we are receiving the greatest hospitality. We are receiving the Word of God in the Holy Scripture Readings, that is, we are sitting beside the Lord at his feet listening to him. Then, we are receiving the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are being nourished for our journey through life to eternal life.

After 2000 years we are still doing what Jesus told us to do. Jesus runs to us and invites us to be with him and be nourished by him. What a blessing it is to participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. What a blessing it is to be with our crucified and risen Lord as he gives us his Body and his Blood.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL DRIVE for Homeless Kids

Justice + Peace Ministry is  hosting a back-to-school drive for the children at Colette's Children's Home (CCH). CCH operates several local shelters serving women and children who have fallen into homelessness due to crises such as job loss or domestic violence. Last year, CCH received 2,474 requests for help and was able to provide housing and supportive services to 315 homeless women and children in Orange County. Children range in age from kindergarten to high school. Justice + Peace Ministry would like to send these children back to school with the clothes and supplies needed to do well. We ask our parish community to join in this effort.

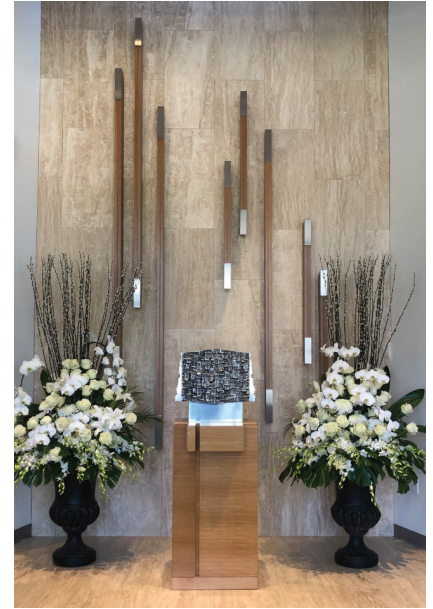

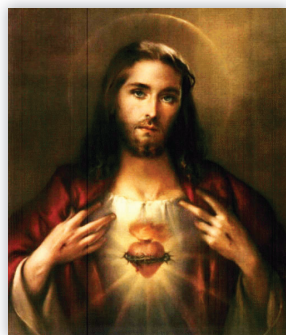

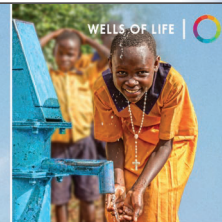
