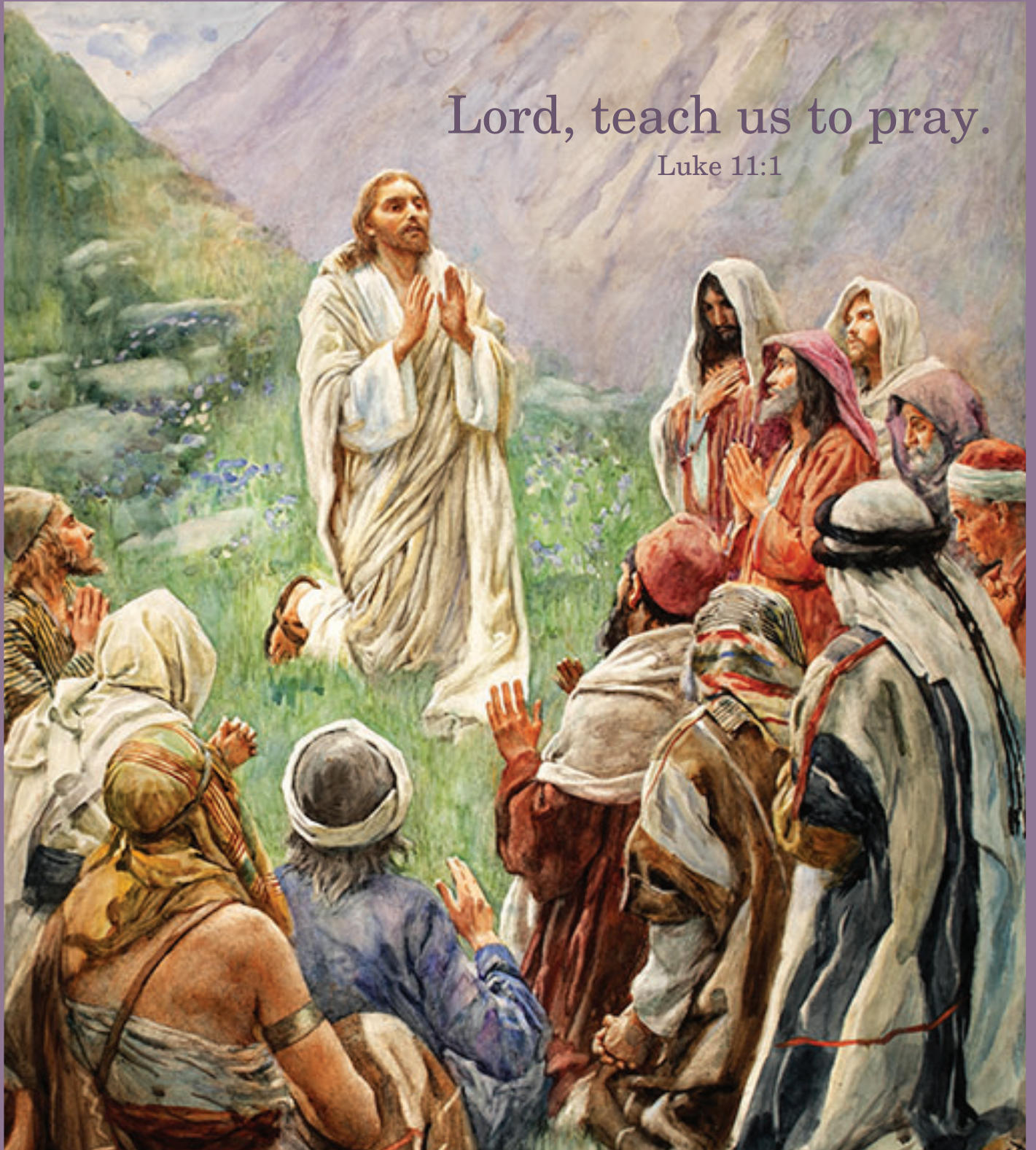

Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel Reading on this Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus taught his disciples to pray:

Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread and forgives us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us, and do not subject us to the final test.

(Luke 11:2-4, *New American Bible, Revised Edition*)

Then Jesus taught his disciples to be persistent in prayer. He told a parable about a man who asked his neighbor to give him bread for his friend who had just arrived from a journey. His neighbor had already secured his house and refused to let him in. Eventually he did open and gave him bread because of his persistence. Jesus said: "Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." Jesus told his disciples to ask for the Holy Spirit and his Father will give him to you. (Luke 11:5-13)

Jesus wants us to know that our prayers will be answered. However, remember when you asked things from your parents and sometimes they gave you what you asked for and sometimes the answer to your request was, "No." You just couldn't understand why they wouldn't give you a high-performance street racing car with a 440-blueprint engine, quad carb. How unreasonable!

So sometimes what we ask God for, is not what is best for us.

In the First Reading today, Abraham pleaded with God to save Sodom from destruction for the sake of the innocent people there. He negotiated with God to not destroy the city if there were fifty innocent people. But Abraham did not stop there, he kept lowering the number of innocents to ten. God agreed not to destroy Sodom for the sake of the ten. Too bad Abraham did not go lower. God's angels only found Lot, his wife, and their two daughters. The angels got them out of Sodom and then God destroyed Sodom and the rest of the cities on the Plain because of their debauchery.

God wants us to pray to him. He wants us to be persistent in prayer. He wants us to know that he does hear and answer our prayers. Remember how Jesus prayed to his Father on the Mount of Olives, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me; still, not my will but yours be done" (Luke 22:42). It is best that when we pray, we include, "Father, not my will but yours be done."

When you pray, remember that you are speaking with our loving God. You are communicating with the One who wants you to be with him for eternity. What we ask for needs to reflect this. That's why Jesus tells us to pray for the Holy Spirit. So, I encourage you to pray: "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in us the fire of your love."

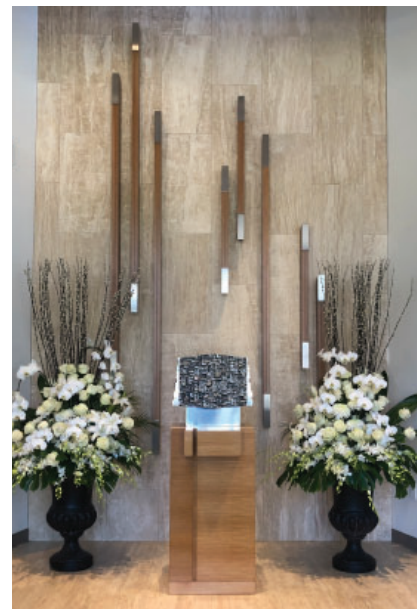
As a measure of safety, we are locking all the side entry doors to the church. Please enter through the front of the church. You can exit via any door; the only entry is via the front doors. I realize this is a little inconvenient for some of you and appreciate your understanding in accommodating this small change for the sake of safety. The change will be in effect by the time you read this in the bulletin.

I want to give you a heads-up on an upcoming event that I hope you will ALL attend. The weekend of October 22-23 we will be having a "registration update" event. Our records are in need of updates, so after all Masses that weekend, we are asking all of you to come by the parish hall after Mass and update your address and emails. We have found that we don't have many email addresses, which limits our ability to reach out and share information directly. As a small token of thanks, we have ordered some really nice St. Bonaventure blue coffee mugs. So come on by and update your records. Have a donut or bagel and get a new coffee cup for the collection (1 per family).

On a related note, we want to encourage our parishioners away from "envelope giving" and toward ACH. ACH stands for Automated Clearing House, a U.S. financial network used for electronic payments and money transfers. Also known as "direct payments," ACH payments are a way to transfer money from one bank account to another without using paper checks, credit card networks, wire transfers, or cash.

While this won't be "a fit" for everyone, for those who are comfortable, I'm hoping you will consider the change. The amount of time, resources, and money it takes for us to process envelopes is significant. I'll be writing more on this in the coming weeks, but hope you will consider the change. We will have a brief "how to" in the bulletin next week. More to come on this!

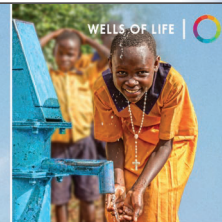
