PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As I was writing this Pastor's Corner this afternoon, I heard someone talking outside the rectory. I quickly looked out the window and saw three teenage girls riding their bicycles passed the side of the church close to the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. As the last girl rode by, she made the Sign of the Cross as she looked into the Chapel window. This touched my heart. As Jesus said, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be" (Luke 12:34).

This is what it's all about. That girl is our future. She is not afraid to acknowledge that the Holy Communion in the Tabernacle is the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God. She is the leaven in the dough that helps our faith grow. She is the vigilant servant of the Lord.

On this Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we hear in the Gospel reading Jesus addressing those servants who remain vigilant, "Blessed are those servants whom the master finds vigilant on his arrival. Amen, I say to you, he will gird himself, have them recline at table, and proceed to wait on them. ... Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour when the thief was coming, he would not have let his house be broken into. You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come" (Luke 12:37-40).

On the Cross, Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit" (Luke 23:46). Put yourselves into the hands of the Lord. As I mentioned last week, call upon the Holy Spirit. He will help you stay vigilant in seeking heavenly treasure.

The Body and Blood of Christ is our heavenly treasure. This is the precious nourishment for our journey to heaven.

BRINGING YOUR MARRIAGE INTO THE CHURCH Convalidations at St. Bonaventure

There are many people attending Catholic parishes or in Catholic families whose marriage is somehow not fully recognized by the Church.

Catholic Church law ordinarily requires baptized Roman Catholics to marry before a priest or deacon. Unless they requested and received a "dispensation from canonical form," Catholics who exchange marriage vows in the presence of only ministers from other religious traditions or authorized civic officials are not considered validly married in the eyes of the Catholic Church.

When a couple wishes to have the Church recognize their union, it is called a convalidation. Regardless of why couples married outside the Church, we wish to support their seeking Information on the necessary preparations for convalidation. Each couple is unique in their circumstances, thus each couple will be unique in their preparation. Most people opt for a simple ceremony.

The benefits of convalidation are many: peace of heart, oneness with the Church, full access to the sacraments, and God's special blessing upon the marriage through the Sacrament of Matrimony.

How does this work at St. Bonaventure?

1. Contact the priest for an appointment to discuss your situation and determine what must be done.
2. Obtain a newly issued copy of the baptismal record for the Catholic party. Make that request to the parish where the person(s) was baptized.
3. If necessary, seek a Church declaration of nullity of any previous marriages. A favorable decision is needed before a convalidation can be scheduled.
4. Complete all appropriate documentation as deemed necessary by your situation.
5. Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation before the convalidation ceremony. Your priest will help you prepare for this.

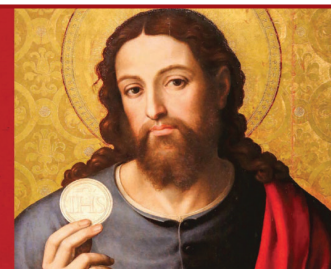

Before the pandemic, St. Bonaventure had a wonderful Pastoral Care Ministry, providing "friendly visitors" to homebound parishioners.



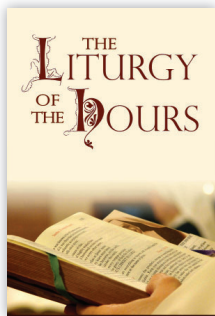

**LITURGY OF THE HOURS****(The Divine Office)**

By tradition going back to early Christian times, the Divine Office is devised so that the whole course of the day and night is made holy by the praises of God. Therefore, when this wonderful song of praise is rightly performed by priests or by the faithful praying together, then it is truly the voice of the bride addressed to her bridegroom; it is the very prayer which Christ

himself, together with his body, addresses to the Father. (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*, no. 84) The Liturgy of the Hours then, is not only the prayer of clerics, but the very prayer of all the Church.

The Liturgy of the Hours (Morning Prayer) is recited weekdays at 6:00 a.m. and Saturdays at 7:00 a.m. in the church.
