PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy New Year! However, more importantly, happy Solemnity in honor of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. In the first centuries of the Church, there arose various heresies that either denied that the Son of God became man or denied that Jesus was the Son of God. Other heresies taught variations on these or blended the heresies. Many Councils of the Church met to deal with these heresies and assist people in what we truly believe. For a more in-depth understanding of this, read the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, sections 456 to 507. I would like to concentrate on section 466 which gives us an important dogma of our faith:

Christ's humanity has no other subject than the divine person of the Son of God, who assumed it and made it his own, from his conception. For this reason the Council of Ephesus proclaimed in 431 that Mary truly became the Mother of God by the human conception of the Son of God in her womb: "Mother of God, not that the nature of the Word or his divinity received the beginning of its existence from the holy Virgin, but that, since the holy body, animated by a rational soul, which the Word of God united to himself according to the hypostasis, was born from her, the Word is said to be born according to the flesh."

Then in section 467 we hear about the Council of Chalcedon that convened in the year 451:

Following the holy Fathers, we unanimously teach and confess one and the same Son, our Lord Jesus Christ: the same perfect in divinity and perfect in humanity, the same truly God and truly man, composed of rational soul and body; consubstantial with the Father as to his divinity and consubstantial with us as to his humanity; "like us in all things but sin." He was begotten from the Father before all ages as to his divinity and in these last days, for us and for our salvation, was born as to his humanity of the virgin Mary, the Mother of God.

We confess that the one and the same Christ, Lord, and only-begotten Son, is to be acknowledged in two natures without confusion, change, division, or separation. The distinction between the natures was never abolished by their union, but rather the character proper to each of the two natures was preserved as they came together in one person (*prosopon*) and one hypostasis.

I know this is complicated theology. What is important is realizing how much God, our Father, loves us, that he would send his only Son to free us from our sins and raise us up to eternal life. Mary said to the Angel, "Behold, I am the maidservant of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." (Luke 1:38) The Holy Spirit came upon her and the power of the Most High overshadowed her.

Thank you, Blessed Virgin Mary, for saying, "Yes" to God the Father. Thank you for saying, "Yes" to becoming the Mother of God.

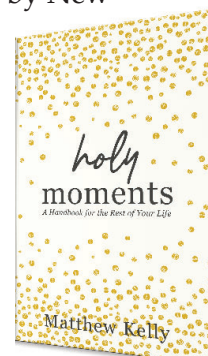

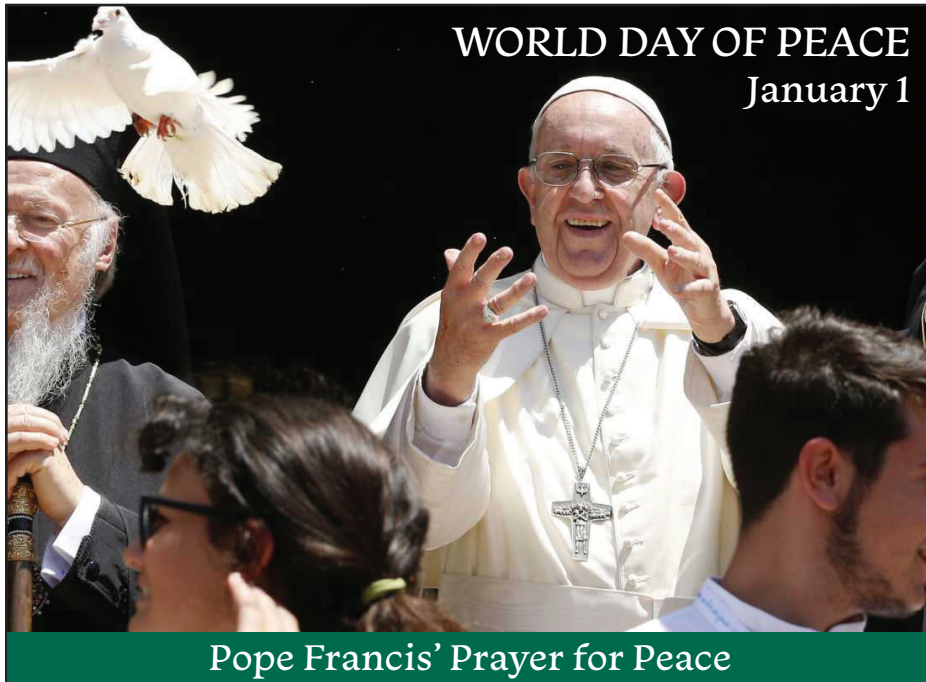

Renew our hearts and minds, so that the word which always brings us together will be "brother," and our way of life will always be that of: Shalom, Peace, Salaam! Amen.

Every year on January 1, the Holy Father marks the World Day of Peace with a special message inviting all people to reflect on the important work of building peace. This year's message is the latest in a long tradition of messages for this day that began with St. Paul VI in 1967. —uscbb.org

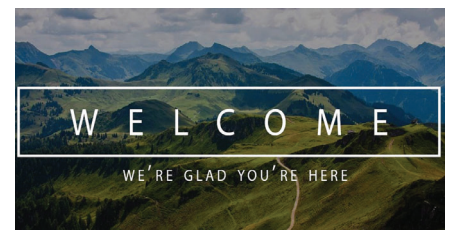
MONTHLY ADORATION Saturday, January 7

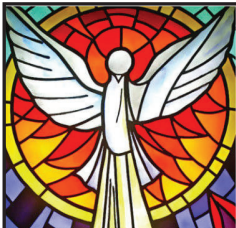

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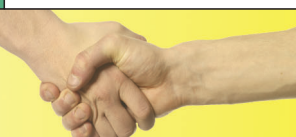
