Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As I shared with you last week, I am leading a group of 55 people to the World Youth Day 2023 and after that, Spain, Lourdes, and Rome, here are the few highlights of our trip the past few days. Our flight arrived in Lisbon safely at 9:00 a.m. local time on Friday. All of us, the oldest is 84 and the youngest is 16, are safe and sound. It was quite crowded at the airport, but everything moved rather quickly. Within two hours, we were on our bus heading to the Santarem Church for our first visit.

This church is very small and old, but its history is very spiritually rich because it has contained the most famous Eucharistic miracle for almost 800 years. In the year 2000, I got to see this Miraculous Eucharistic Host when I was there, but this time we only got to see the tabernacle. It was very crowded because of the WYD. From Fr. Ben Tran's Facebook, I saw Bishop Thanh, together with a group of priests and a large crowd from the Diocese of Orange, having Mass there. What a great opportunity that was. Our group joined with a bishop and people from Poland for Mass when we got there. After Mass we headed for our hotel in Fatima.

Fatima is best known for the apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary to the three children Lúcia, Francisco, and Jacinta, in 1917. The messages that Mary instructed the children to tell the world was to pray the Rosary, repent of their sins, and give honor to the Sacred Heart. Since then, every year, millions of pilgrims come here to honor Mary. On our first night, we joined thousands of pilgrims praying the Rosary and participated in the processions. The next morning, the Holy Father was scheduled to come pray the Rosary at 9:00 a.m., but as early as 5:00 a.m. there were thousands of people already there, and many other thousands camped out all night for a good view of the Holy Father. When his papal mobile began to roll, there was a great sound of joy everywhere. Reuter estimated about 200,000 people gathered for this event. In his brief message, the Holy Father emphasized, "Our Lady who goes with haste and always accompanies, is never the protagonist, she always follows Jesus."

In the afternoon, twenty of us made our trip back to Lisbon to join 1.5 million others for the final day of the World Youth Day 2023. It was quite an event. Because of the enormous crowd, all buses had to unload their passengers miles away. So we walked for hours to get to Parque Tejo. Here is how Reuter described it: "The Parque Tejo, a new venue created for the event, covers 100 hectares (250 acres) and has no shade or structures. Some participants had to wait up to 20 minutes to refill their water bottles as temperatures reached 38 degrees Celsius (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit)." When we got here people were as numerous as ants. Like a passage in Revelation describes, "a great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue" were singing, dancing, and praising Jesus. We made our way through the crowd and found a little space to settle for the night. No tent, no sleeping bag, no problem. With large screens throughout the park, we were able to listen to talks, view entertainment, and adore the Eucharist. The morning of the last day of the WYD, we were awoken with blast of rocking music, of course spiritual music, to get us ready for Sunday Mass at 9:00 a.m. The Holy Father celebrated the Mass with hundreds of bishops, thousands of priests, and 1.5 million others. On this feast of the Transfiguration, he challenged the youth to shine, to listen, and to be unafraid. He said, "We become luminous, we shine, when, welcoming Jesus, we learn to love like Him. To love like Jesus: that makes us luminous, that leads us to do works of love."

We were tired, but we left the event with great joy. Tonight (Sunday night), our group will gather again for Rosary and procession at the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. Five language groups have been chosen to lead each decade, and we are fortunate to be one of the five. Tomorrow I get to be the celebrant for the Mass here at 5:00 a.m. After that we will be leaving Fatima for Spain.

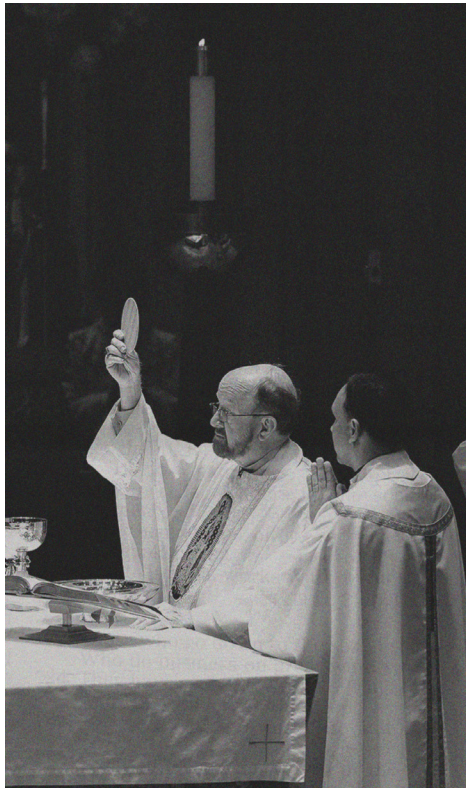

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XIX MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM A

Thưa quý ông bà và anh chị em:

Như tôi đã chia sẻ trong bản thông tin tuần trước, trong tuần này tôi đang dẫn phái đoàn 55 người đi hành hương, khởi đầu với Đại Hội Giới Trẻ ở Lisbon, Bồ Đào Nha, sau đó là kính viếng Đức Mẹ Fatima, Đức Mẹ Lộ Đức, và sau cùng là Rôma. Phái đoàn chúng tôi đã đáp máy bay ở Lisbon an toàn. Trên đường về khách sạn ở Fatima, chúng tôi trước hết kính viếng nhà thờ Santarem. Một nhà thờ nhỏ tại một tỉnh lẻ heo lánh, nhưng nơi đây đang lưu giữ một phép lạ Thánh Thể nổi tiếng trong Giáo Hội gần 800 năm qua. Vì đang trong những ngày của ĐHGTT nên lượng người lui tới rất tập, và chúng tôi chỉ có thể kính viếng Thánh Thể trong nhà tạm chứ không được chiêm ngưỡng qua mặt nhật. Sau đó chúng tôi rời nơi đây để về khách sạn tại Fatima.

Fatima là linh địa nổi tiếng trong Giáo Hội. Nơi đây vào năm 1917, Đức Mẹ đã hiện ra với ba trẻ Lucia, Francisco, và Jacinta và truyền cho các em ba mệnh lệnh mà chúng ta đã quen thuộc nhờ bài hát, “Lời Mẹ Nhắc Nhủ,” của Huyền Linh: ăn năn đền tội, tôn sùng Mẫu Tâm, và năng lần hạt mân côi. Từ đó Fatima được nhiều người biết đến, và hàng năm có khoảng năm triệu người đến hành hương nơi đây. Ngay đêm đầu tiên, chúng tôi được cùng hàng chục ngàn người lần hạt và rước kiệu Đức Mẹ. Sang ngày hôm sau, theo chương trình thì Đức Thánh Cha sẽ đến lần hạt tại Đài Đức Mẹ vào lúc 9:00 sáng, nhưng mới có 5:00 đã có cả hàng ngàn người tập hợp nơi đây, chưa kể nhiên ngàn người khác đã ngủ đêm chờ sẵn, dọc theo lộ trình Đức Thánh Cha đi xe vào linh đài. Khi ĐTC tới gần, nhạc cụ và tiếng reo hò của các tín hữu nổi lên vang dậy khắp quảng trường. Theo Reuters ước lượng, có khoảng 200,000 người đã tham dự buổi lần hạt này với ĐTC. Trong một bài giảng ngắn gọn, ĐTC nói rằng, “Đức Mẹ của chúng ta đã vội vã lên đường và luôn luôn đồng hành. Mẹ không bao giờ thu hút sự chú ý về mình, nhưng luôn bước theo Chúa Giêsu.”

Trong buổi chiều ngày hôm đó, 20 người chúng tôi trở lại Lisbon để tham dự đêm canh thức của Đại Hội Giới Trẻ. Đây là biến cố vĩ đại chưa từng thấy tại nơi đây. Số lượng người đổ về đại hội chiều hôm đó quá đông, nên các xe bus phải đậu ở rất xa. Chúng tôi phải đi bộ có đến bốn hoặc năm miles. Dưới đây là một đoạn được Reuters tường thuật, “Công Viên Tejo, một địa điểm mới được dựng nên cho đại hội, có diện tích 100 ha (250 acres) và không có bóng râm hay lều bạt gì cả. Nhiều người tham gia đã phải đợi tới 20 phút để đổ đầy chai nước của họ khi nhiệt độ lên tới 38 độ C (100.4 độ F).” Khi chúng tôi đến đây, người đông như kiến cỏ ở khắp mọi nơi. Tôi chợt nhớ đến một câu Kinh Thánh trong sách Khải Huyền nói rằng, “Kìa một đoàn người thật đông không tài nào đếm nổi, thuộc mọi dân, mọi chi tộc, mọi nước và mọi ngôn ngữ” (Kh 7:9). Đoàn người này đang ca hát, nhảy múa rất hồn nhiên trong tâm tình ca tụng Thiên Chúa. Khó khăn lắm chúng tôi mới len lỏi qua đám đông để tìm được một khoảng đất nhỏ nhỏ để tạm ngả lưng cho đêm tối. Nhờ vào những màn ảnh lớn dựng nhiều góc cạnh khác nhau trong công viên, nên chúng tôi có thể thông công những buổi hội thảo, văn nghệ, và châu Thánh Thể. Sau đó, các nhóm và các hội đoàn ca hát nhảy múa tới rất khuya.

Sáng hôm sau mới khoảng 7:00, một hồi nhạc rock, dĩ nhiên là nhạc đạo, vang lên rất lớn, làm nhiều người, nhất là các bạn trẻ đang ngủ cũng phải bật dậy, nhảy múa và ca hát theo tiếng nhạc.
