PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In my "Pastor's Corner" last week, I reflected on what we might miss when we come to Mass late. I hope this little reflection has reached many people. If not, I hope you will let others know about it. It is still available online at stbonaventure.org. For this week, I would like to look into the Concluding Rites of the Mass and what we might miss when we leave church early.

The Concluding Rites begins after the Prayer after Communion, and it has three parts: Optional announcements; Greeting and Blessing; and Dismissal. As I stand in the courtyard waiting to meet parishioners after Mass, I see some people actually leave church as soon as they receive Holy Communion. A few go back inside when they see me, as if I will yell at them for leaving early. Rest assured that I will not do that. I respect your decision to leave early because you might have something urgent to attend to, but if you can stay, please remain until the end of the recessional hymn. If you leave early, you will miss much grace which you truly deserve.

Let's start with those missing the Prayer after Communion. The moment after you receive Holy Communion is the most sacred and personal time between you and Jesus, who has just entered your heart in a visible and concrete way. In the silence of your heart, talk to Him about anything that is going on in your mind. If you do not feel like saying anything, reflect on the lyrics of the communion hymn which will help you to connect with Jesus. If you struggle to find something to say to Jesus, I recommend this simple prayer, which priests or deacons pray inaudibly as they purify the vessels: "What has passed our lips as food, O Lord, may we possess in purity of heart, that what is given to us in time, be our healing for eternity." Very soon in the pew, you will see a new prayer card which has different prayers for you to pray after Communion, but no prayer is dearer to Jesus than the prayer from your heart.

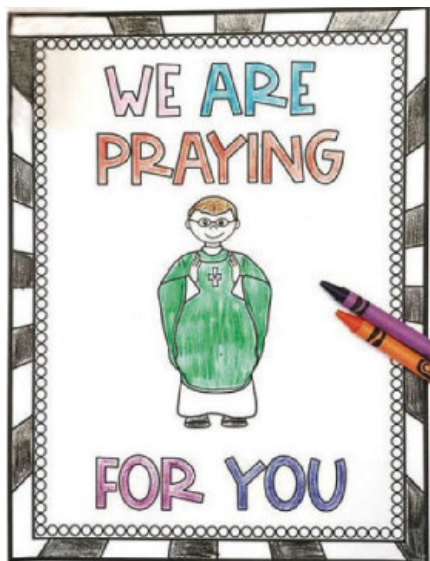
After everyone receives Holy Communion, there is usually a moment of silence for personal prayer and for preparation of the Prayer after Communion. In this prayer, the Church prays that the benefits of the Eucharist will remain active in our daily lives. For example, in the prayer for this Sunday, the Church prays that, "we may come to possess the redemption both in mystery and in the manner of our life." The benefit highlighted in this prayer is the redemption flowing from the Eucharist that we just received. As this prayer is read out loud, we can feel in our bones what a great joy that is to our soul.

The next prayer that our parish recites together is the "Prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel." This prayer was written by Pope Leo XIII in 1884, and he ordered that it be recited at the end of Mass for the protection of the Church from her enemies. As we have learned, St. Michael the Archangel fights to reestablish divine justice. He defends the Church and all of us "against the wickedness and snares of the Devil." The Church constantly has to deal with the power of Satan, so asking for this divine defense is definitely our duty, not only for the Church, but also for our daily life.

Well, I did not really get into the Concluding Rites, and the "corner" is already long enough. I stop here and will reflect on them next week.

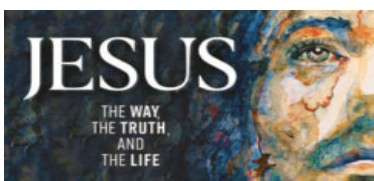

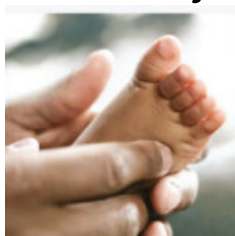

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXV MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM A Mt 20, 1-16a " **Hãy mắt bạn ganh tị, vì tôi nhân lành chẳng**".

Tuần trước tôi có chia sẻ về những ân sủng chúng ta đã vô tình bỏ qua khi đi Lễ trễ. Tôi hy vọng nhiều người đã có dịp đọc qua. Những ai đã đọc rồi, quý vị vui lòng nhắc nhở nhau tìm đọc. Bài viết hiện vẫn còn trên website của giáo xứ, stbonaventure.org. Tuần này, tôi chia sẻ tiếp về những ân sủng mà chúng ta đón nhận được từ Nghi Thức Kết Lễ, và nếu chúng ta cố tình bỏ về trước khi Thánh Lễ kết thúc, thì chúng ta đã bỏ qua những ân sủng này.

Nghi Thức Kết Lễ bắt đầu ngay sau Lời Nguyện Hiệp Lễ, và nó có ba phần: Thông báo, Phép lành, và Giải tán. Trong những lần đứng đợi giáo dân ra về, tôi thấy có một số người vừa rước Lễ xong là bỏ về ngay. Một số người mở cửa ra nhìn thấy tôi, vội vàng trở vào bên trong, dường như sợ tôi la. Quý ông bà và anh chị em yên trí. Tôi tôn trọng chọn lựa của quý vị về sớm hay về trễ, chứ không dám la ai, vì biết đâu quý vị có những công việc cấp bách cần phải giải quyết. Tuy nhiên, nếu hoàn cảnh cho phép, quý vị nên ở lại cho đến hết ca kết Lễ, vì nếu về sớm, quý vị sẽ bỏ mất những ân sủng đúng ra mình đáng được lãnh nhận.

Ngay sau khi rước Lễ, đây là giây phút rất linh thiêng và riêng tư quý báu với Chúa Kitô vừa mới ngự vào trong tâm hồn mình một cách rõ ràng và chắc chắn. Trong thinh lặng, quý vị hãy thưa với Chúa tất cả những suy tư thầm kín. Nếu không muốn nói gì, quý vị có thể lắng nghe và suy gẫm lời ca hiệp Lễ. Nó sẽ giúp quý vị cảm nhận được sự hiện diện của Chúa. Nếu không biết nói gì cùng Chúa, tôi đề nghị đọc lời kinh giản dị này mà tôi rất thích, "Lạy Chúa, miệng con vừa rước Mình Thánh Chúa, xin cho con tiếp nhận với tâm hồn trong sạch, và xin cho ân huệ đời này trở nên linh dược cho con được sống muôn đời." Đây là lời nguyện mà các linh mục hay các thầy phó tế đọc thầm khi tráng chén. Ít tuần nữa, chúng tôi sẽ để tại các hàng ghế các bản kinh để quý vị có thể đọc sau rước Lễ. Tuy nhiên, vẫn không có lời nguyện nào quý hơn đối với Chúa Giêsu bằng lời nguyện đến từ tâm hồn của chúng ta.

Sau khi mọi người rước Lễ xong, thường có giây phút thinh lặng để chúng ta tâm tình với Chúa và cũng để chuẩn bị cho Lời Nguyện Hiệp Lễ. Trong lời nguyện này, Giáo Hội cầu cho những hiệu quả thiêng liêng từ phép Thánh Thể trở nên sống động trong cuộc đời chúng ta. Chẳng hạn như trong lời nguyện Chúa Nhật này, Giáo Hội cầu xin rằng chúng ta "được hưởng nhờ hiệu quả ơn cứu chuộc trong Thánh Lễ cũng như trong đời sống hàng ngày." Hiệu quả thiêng liêng đến từ phép Thánh Thể mà chúng ta đón nhận được đó là ơn cứu chuộc. Khi lời nguyện này được đọc lên, chúng ta cảm thấy một niềm hân hoan dâng trào phủ kín tâm hồn chúng ta.

Lời kinh kế tiếp mà giáo xứ chúng ta thường đọc chung với nhau đó "Kinh Cầu Cùng Tổng Lãnh Thiên Thần Micae." Kinh nguyện này do Đức Giáo Hoàng Lêô XIII viết ra vào năm 1884, và truyền cho các tín hữu đọc vào cuối Thánh Lễ để xin ơn che chở cho Giáo Hội, tránh được sự quấy phá của kẻ thù là ma quỷ. Khi đọc kinh này, Giáo Hội tin rằng Tổng Lãnh Thiên Thần sẽ giúp chúng ta, "đánh phá sự hiểm ác mưu sâu quỷ dữ." Vì Giáo Hội thường xuyên phải chống trả lại mưu chước của Satan, nên chúng ta cần phải thành tâm cầu xin cho Giáo Hội và cho cả mỗi người chúng ta nữa.

Bài viết cũng đã khá dài, mà chưa nói gì đến Nghi Thức Kết Lễ. Tôi tạm dừng ở đây và tuần sau sẽ viết đúng chủ đề.

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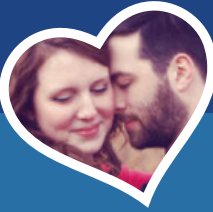
