October is the Month of the *Holy Rosary*

By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicates each month of the year to a certain devotion. The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. October includes the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7). **The best way to celebrate the month is, of course, to pray the Rosary.**

But why is it that on October 7th the Catholic Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary? On October 7, 1571, a great victory over the mighty Turkish fleet was won by Catholic naval forces primarily from Spain, Venice, and Genoa under the command of Don Juan of Austria. It was the last battle at sea between "oared" ships, which featured the most powerful navy in the world, a Muslim force with between 12,000 to 15,000 Christian slaves as rowers.

The patchwork team of Catholic ships was powered by the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Knowing that the Christian forces were at a distinct material disadvantage, the Holy Pontiff **St. Pope Pius V** called for all of Europe to pray the Rosary for victory.

We know today that the victory of the Christian forces in the Battle of Lepanto prevented the Islamic invasion of Europe, and evidenced the Hand of God working through Our Lady. The Battle of Lepanto was at first celebrated liturgically as "Our Lady of Victory." Later, the feast of October 7th was renamed "Our Lady of the Rosary" and extended throughout the Universal Church by Pope Clement XI in 1716.

And with that we remember the six apparitions of Our Lady



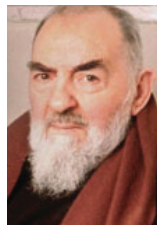
to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal in 1917. There Our Lady, when asked her name, said: **"I am the Lady of the Rosary."** At Fatima, Our Lady taught us to pray the Rosary every day. Heaven presented its peace plan at Fatima and truly gave us hope for the world. In Fatima Our Lady said, "Say the rosary every day ... pray, pray a lot and offer sacrifices for sinners ... I am Our Lady of the Rosary ... In the end my Immaculate Heart will triumph." Our Lady of the Rosary, pray for us!

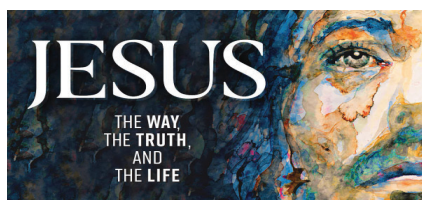

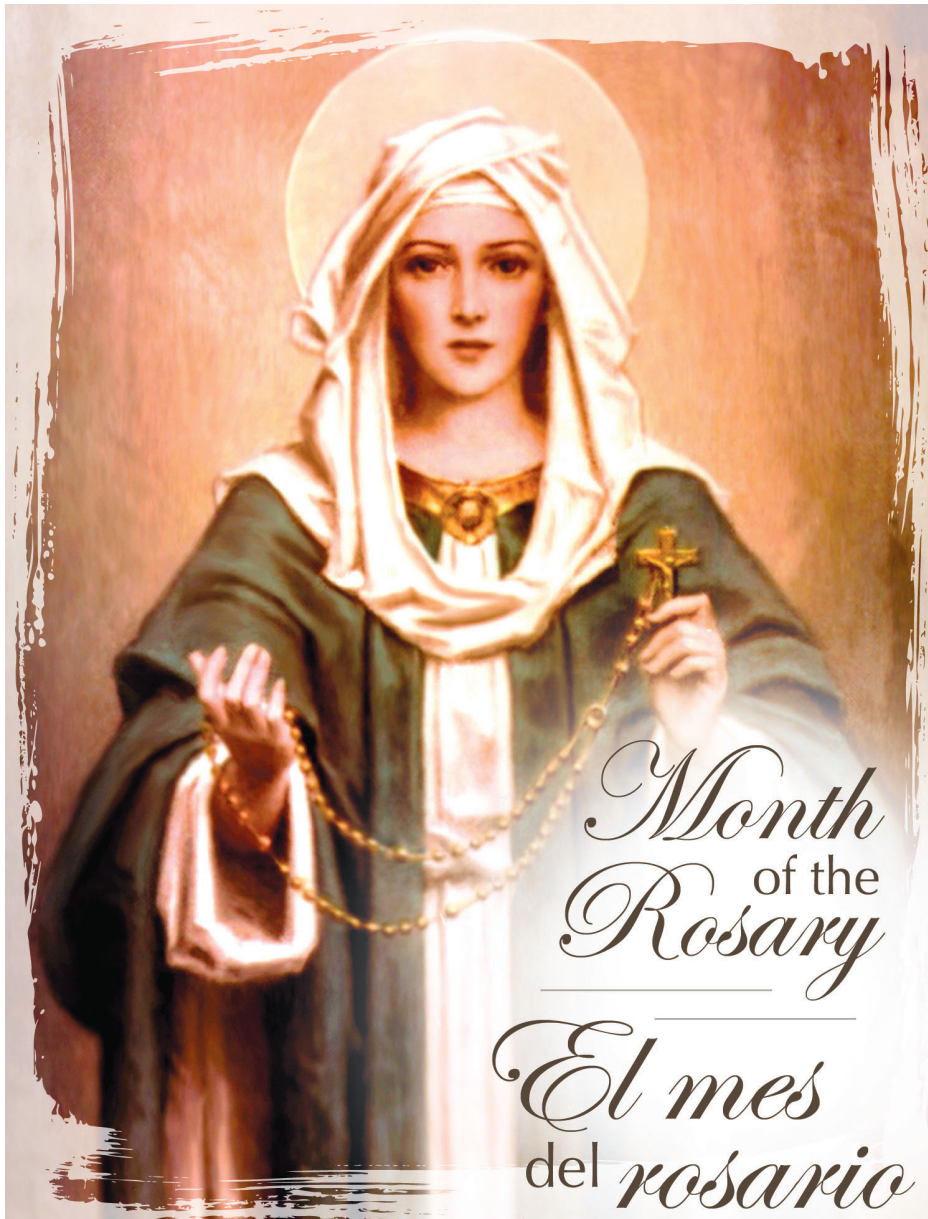

Sáng nay như thường lệ, tôi ghé thăm các em trong buổi đọc kinh đầu tuần và hỏi các em đã sẵn sàng vui chơi hội chợ chưa, các em thưa "Yes" lớn lắm. Chân thành cảm ơn cha mẹ các em đã quảng đại ủng hộ cho hội chợ qua việc mua vé cho đồ ăn và trò chơi các loại. Tôi tin rằng những quý vị phụ huynh này sẽ rất hài lòng khi thấy con mình vui chơi trong ba ngày hội chợ.

Trong những tuần vừa qua, số lượng vé bán ra rất nhiều. Ông Steve Ross, trưởng ban điều hành hội chợ, cho biết dựa trên số lượng vé bán ra, chắc chắn sẽ có rất nhiều người đến tham dự. Đây là hội chợ đầu tiên của tôi với giáo xứ, nên tôi cũng như các trẻ em rất háo hức để thấy đông đảo giáo dân quy tụ về đây, và hy vọng là tôi sẽ quen biết thêm được một số người mới.

Nhân dịp này, tôi chân thành cảm ơn tất cả quý ông bà và anh chị em đã góp công góp của cho hội chợ cách này hay cách khác. Rất nhiều người đã hy sinh thời giờ, tài năng, và công của để phục vụ. Nhiều tháng qua Ban Hội Chợ đã thường xuyên hội họp để chuẩn bị, và tôi cũng có dịp tham dự một số những buổi họp này. Điều làm tôi rất ngưỡng mộ những người tình nguyện phục vụ, đó là tinh thần cộng tác với nhau. Tôi chưa thấy ai than phiền về điều gì. Mọi người đều nhiệt thành làm tròn bổn phận của mình để cho khách tham dự được vui vẻ và quý mến nhau.

Riêng cộng đoàn Việt Nam, liên tục trong ba bốn ngày của tuần lễ trước ngày hội chợ, mọi người hẹn nhau tới để ướp thịt, quần chả giò, xào thịt, vv. Những người khác thì lo nấu ăn cho những người làm việc. Nhiều người khác vì không tới giúp được, nên đã hỗ trợ tài chánh để mua đồ ăn. Chắc chắn công việc sẽ mất rất nhiều thời giờ, nhưng vì đây là công việc chung của giáo xứ nên mọi người sẵn sàng đến với tinh thần hy sinh.

Giáo xứ chúng ta là một cộng đồng Thánh Thể đạo hạnh, và cũng là một tập thể thân thiện với nhau. Hàng ngày hoặc hàng tuần chúng ta cùng đến thờ phượng và cầu nguyện cho nhau, cách riêng cho những người đau ốm, cao niên, và những linh hồn đã qua đời. Chúng ta cũng rất trân trọng tinh thần hiệp nhất và tinh thần ái. Đây chính là cách để chúng ta xây dựng một giáo xứ sống động. Xin Thiên Chúa luôn chúc lành cho mỗi người chúng ta để chúng ta không ngừng chiếu tỏa vương quốc của Ngài ở trên trời ngay tại giáo xứ của chúng ta.

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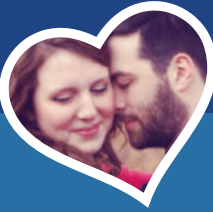
