PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Praise and thanks to God and to all of you for supporting me with a prayerful Installation Mass and festive reception. I would like to mention all by name, but there are too many to put in writing. May God bless you all in a special way for your love and participation in the event.

As I reflect upon this great event, I would like to share with you a few important points about how my life of service will be at St. Bonaventure Parish. In the Order of Installation of a Pastor, Bishop Vann presented me three essential groups in the parish: the Parish Staff, the Pastoral Council, and the Finance Council. With each group, he instructed me as follows:

1. The **Parish Staff** "will assist you in the pastoral care of the people of this parish. Share this ministry in a spirit of mutual trust, common prayer, and genuine concern."
2. The **Pastoral Council** "is the voice of your people and will assist and counsel you as you minister to this parish. Always be attentive to the needs they express."
3. The **Finance Council** "will aid you in the administration of parish finances and the parish's corporate and legal affairs."

The intention of these instructions gives me much comfort and confidence in my service to the parish. It is obvious that I am not alone in my role as pastor, but I have the clergy and parishioners with great dedication and skills to support me. For this, I am very grateful to them.

In addition to these instructions is my Oath of Fidelity. Here is just one important part of the oath:

I shall carry out with the greatest care and fidelity the duties incumbent on me toward both the universal Church and the particular Church in which, according to the provisions of the law, I have been called to exercise my service.

Some key words that I strongly feel about in this promise are **care, fidelity, duties, and service**, which remind me of Jesus' command to his disciples that a leader is not to lord over others but to serve. He then uses Himself as an example, "Just so, the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many" (Mt 20:25-28).

As I am committed to serving your spiritual needs, please continue to keep me in your prayers. When we are praying for one another, God will be in our midst to bless us with peace, joy and unity.

As we look ahead, the month of November is knocking on our doors. It is important to know that this month is dedicated to praying for the Holy Souls in purgatory, where many parishioners and our loved ones are waiting for our prayers. For our Catholic belief, purgatory is real. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* defines purgatory as a "purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." This purification will be given to those "who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified" (CCC 1030). When a soul is awaiting the eternal joy, it needs our prayers and sacrifice. That is why Saint Paul reminds us that we should not forget "about those who have fallen asleep" (1 Thes 4:23).

There are certain acts of charities that we can do for the souls in purgatory. First, obtain a plenary indulgence for them. We can do this by visiting any Catholic church on November 2nd and recite one *Our Father* and the *Creed*. We can also visit a cemetery any day from November 1st to November 8th. Each day we visit, we will gain a plenary indulgence, and these indulgences are applicable to souls in purgatory. Another practical way to pray for the souls is to offer them a nine-day novena. Our parish will be celebrating this novena from November 2nd to November 10th. At all Masses during these nine days, the souls of your loved ones will be prayed for. To participate in this novena, simply write their names on the return envelope and mail it back to the parish, or you can drop it in the collection basket. We will place it by the altar and offer them up to God. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

November 15, 1936–October 15, 2023

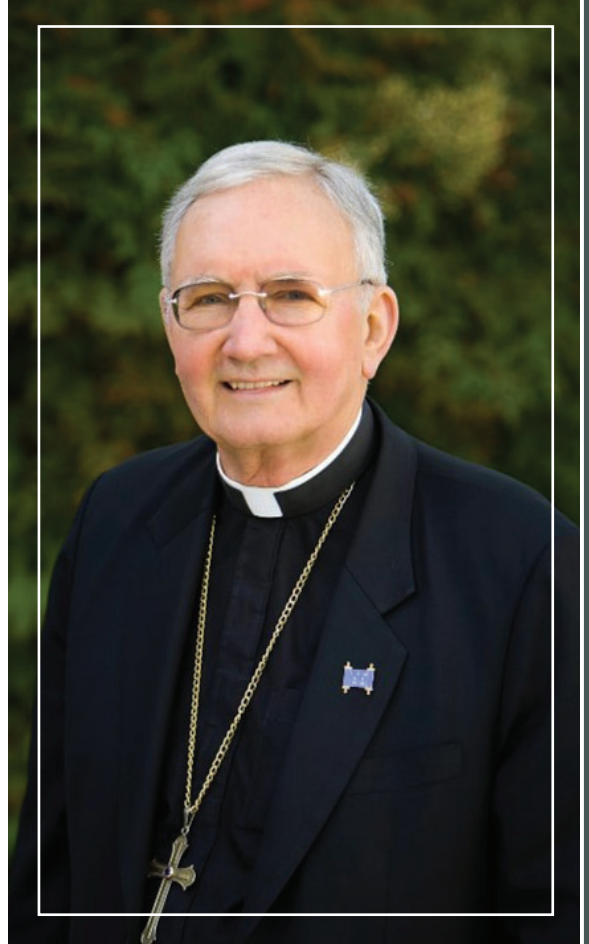
Bishop Kevin Vann and the Roman Catholic Diocese of Orange community are saddened to announce the passing of Bishop Emeritus Tod David Brown.

Bishop Brown died Sunday morning, October 15, 2023 at St. Joseph Hospital. He was 86.

Sustained and heartened by the knowledge of all who had been praying for him, Bishop Brown received the Anointing of the Sick and the Apostolic Pardon.

"With his tireless spirit and witness to Christ, Bishop Brown faithfully served the people of the Diocese of Orange since 1998, when Pope St. John Paul II appointed him bishop and ordinary of our Diocese," said Bishop Vann. "I remember especially his kindness to me when I was a newly ordained priest at the Casa Santa Maria in Rome in the fall of 1981.

"I ask for prayers for the repose of Bishop Brown's soul and for the thanksgiving to God for his many years of ministry and evangelization. Let us pray: Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he and all the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace. 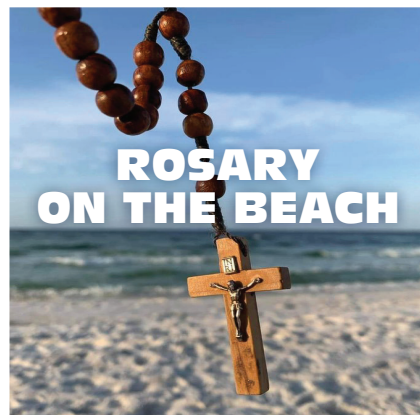

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXX MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM A

Mt 22, 34-40 "Người hãy yêu mến Chúa là Thiên Chúa người, và yêu thương kẻ khác như chính mình người".

Tôi hết lòng tạ ơn Thiên Chúa và chân thành tri ân toàn thể quý cha, quý thầy phó tế, ông bà và anh chị em đã giúp cho Thánh Lễ Bổ Nhiệm Chánh Xứ và tiệc mừng tuần vừa qua được mọi sự tốt đẹp. Tôi rất muốn nêu tên từng người và hội đoàn để cảm ơn, nhưng vì nhiều quá không thể viết hết ra trong khuôn khổ nhỏ bé này. Xin Thiên Chúa luôn chúc phúc lành cho quý vị.

Dưới đây là một vài điểm quan trọng từ nghi thức bổ nhiệm xin được trình bày với quý vị. Trước hết Đức Cha Vann nhắc nhở tôi về vai trò quan trọng của các cha, các thầy phó tế, nhân viên trong giáo xứ, Hội Đồng Giáo Xứ, và Hội Đồng Tài Chánh. Họ là những cộng sự viên đắc lực trong mọi tổ chức và điều hành công việc của giáo xứ. Có được sự cộng tác của họ, tôi thực sự rất may mắn và vững tin trong sứ vụ của mình. Tôi hết lòng tạ ơn Chúa vì đây thực sự là ân sủng đặc biệt Chúa ban cho.

Phần thứ hai của nghi thức là lời tôi tuyên thệ với Thiên Chúa và với Đức Giám Mục. Trong đó có lời này, "Tôi sẽ chuyên cần và trung tín chu toàn trách nhiệm đối với Giáo Hội toàn cầu cũng như đối với Giáo Hội địa phương, nơi tôi được mời gọi đến phục vụ, theo như luật dạy." Trong lời hứa này, một số những từ quan trọng như chuyên cần, trung tín, chu toàn trách nhiệm, và phục vụ, nói lên đặc tính của vai trò linh mục chánh xứ như xưa Chúa Giêsu đã dạy các tông đồ rằng, những người lãnh đạo không thống trị người khác nhưng là phục vụ họ. Ngài đã dùng chính cuộc đời của Ngài làm ví dụ điển hình và nói rằng, "Cũng như Con Người đến không phải để được người ta phục vụ, nhưng để phục vụ và phó mạng làm giá chuộc cho nhiều người" (Mt 20:25-28).

Với lời dạy dỗ của Đức Giám Mục và lời tuyên thệ, tôi sẽ cố gắng hết mình để phục vụ những nhu cầu tâm linh của quý ông bà và anh chị em, và xin quý vị nhớ thường xuyên cầu nguyện cho tôi. Khi chúng ta cầu nguyện cho nhau, Thiên Chúa sẽ ngự đến và chúc phúc cho chúng ta được bình an, vui vẻ, và hiệp nhất.

Đó là một vài điểm quan trọng về Nghi Thức Bổ Nhiệm Chánh Xứ. Chúng ta trở về với sinh hoạt mục vụ trong thời gian này. Chỉ còn ít ngày nữa là bước sang tháng 11, tháng cầu nguyện cho các linh hồn. Ai trong chúng ta cũng có những người thân và bạn bè cần chúng ta cầu nguyện cho họ. Giáo Lý Công Giáo dạy rằng, các linh hồn ở nơi luyện ngục "phải chịu thanh luyện sau khi chết, để đạt được sự thánh thiện cần thiết hầu tiến vào hưởng niềm vui thiên đàng" (1030). Trong thời gian thanh luyện, các linh hồn cần đến sự trợ giúp của chúng ta.

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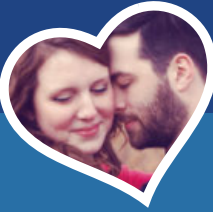
