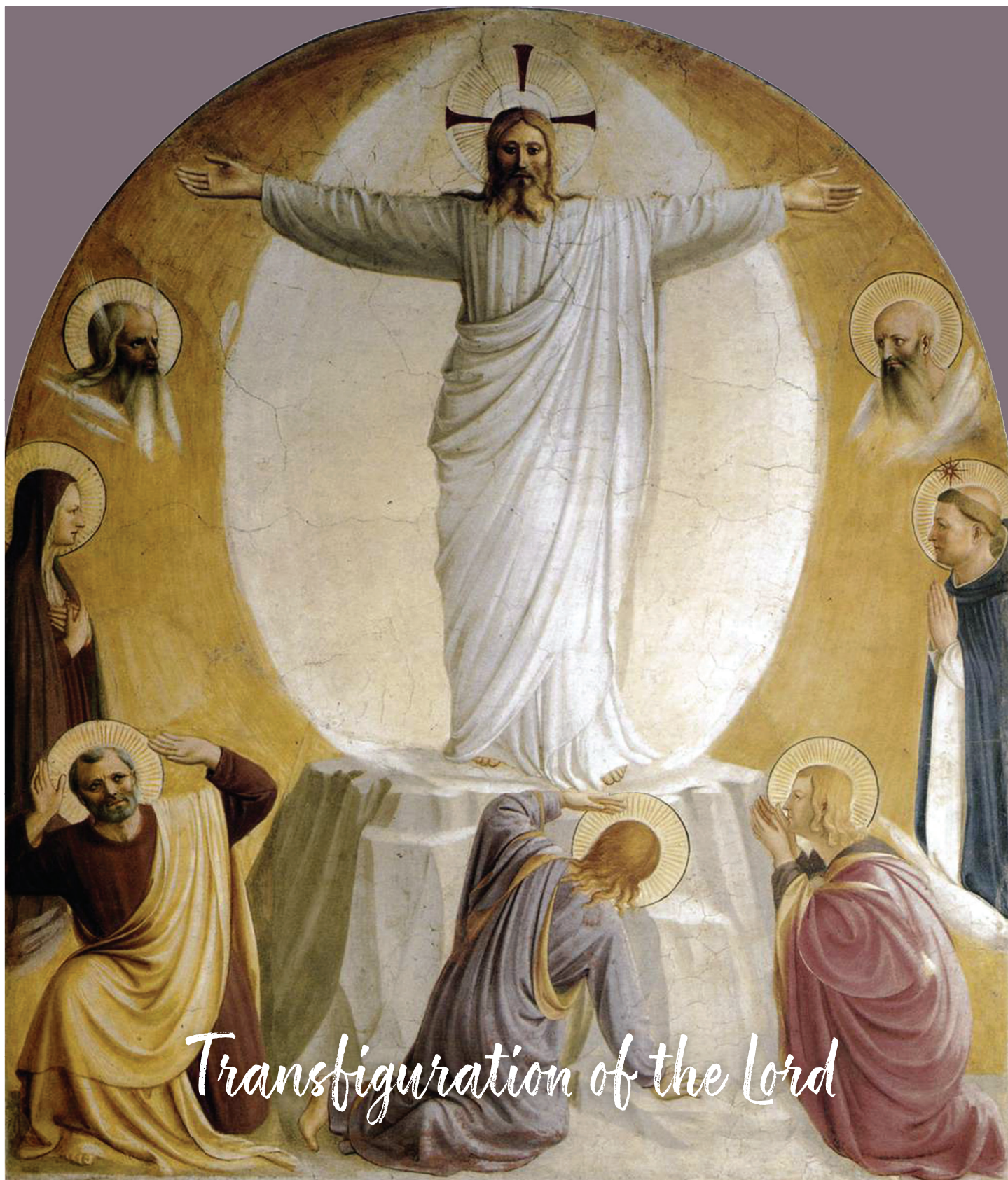

## Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

One of the questions that I asked the students when I visited them in the classrooms last week was, "Why do we Catholics abstain from eating meat on Fridays?" There were some really interesting answers:

- Animals hurt when we kill them for meat.
- Jesus did not eat meat.
- Meat is more expensive than fish.
- People gain weight by eating meat.

The real reason has to do with Jesus being crucified on Fridays. Here is the reason: "From the first century, the day of the crucifixion has been traditionally observed as a day of abstaining from flesh meat ('black fast') to honor Christ who sacrificed his flesh on a Friday" (Klein, P., *Catholic Source Book*, 93).

That is the reason why we do not eat meat on Fridays, especially on Fridays during Lent (*Canon Law #1251*). However, recognizing that this abstinence might be too much for many Catholics, the United States bishops decided in 1966 that Catholics may choose to offer other suitable sacrifices in place of meat. The reason is, "... to many in our day of abstinence from meat no longer implies penance, while renunciation of other things would be more penitential" (*Pastoral Statement on Penance and Abstinence*, #20). The bishops continue: "... even though we hereby terminate the traditional law of abstinence binding under pain of sin, as the sole prescribed means of observing Friday, we give first place to abstinence from flesh meat" (#24). Please note, this statement from the bishops only affects Fridays of other seasons of the year, but abstinence for Fridays during Lent remains unchanged.

The law of abstinence can get complicated when we try to determine what we are allowed to eat and what we should abstain from. Fr. Michael A. Van Sloun's article, "*Why don't Catholics eat meat on Fridays?*" (scan QR code) can help us to choose for ourselves, "Flesh meat includes the meat of mammals and poultry, and the main foods that come under this heading are beef, pork, chicken, and turkey. While flesh is prohibited, the non-flesh products of these animals are not, things like milk, cheese, butter, eggs, and sauces made from animal fats."



Basically, all meats from warm-blooded animals are not to be served on Fridays, especially during Lent. All vegetables and cold-blooded animals are allowed. They include any kind of fish and frogs, clams, turtles, shrimp, crab, and oysters. While lobster and king crab are also allowed on Fridays, because of their luxurious nature, choosing them in place of flesh meat is to defeat the penitential purpose.

The purpose of abstinence is to help us to grow in holiness and honor Christ, who was crucified on Friday for our salvation. Our sacrifice for this penitential abstinence is to die with him. As St. Paul puts it, "If we have died with him we shall also live with him" (2 Tim 2:11).

### **REVEREND TIMOTHY PETERS, S.T.D.** Assistant Professor of Biblical Studies

Fr. Timothy Peters was raised in Southern California and was ordained to the Priesthood on June 7, 2003 for the Diocese of Orange. He completed a License in Biblical theology (S.T.L.) at the Gregorian University from 2009 to 2011. In 2014 he began doctoral studies (S.T.D.) in biblical theology at the Angelicum University in Rome. In 2016 he was assigned to Saint John's Seminary in Camarillo as an Assistant Professor. He successfully defended his doctorate in 2017 on the theme of Messianic Hope in the Second Temple Period. He teaches biblical courses on the Pentateuch, Historical Books, Prophets, Psalms, Wisdom Literature, Introduction to the New Testament and the Synoptic Gospels.

# Q&A

## Q: What are the Scrutinies? PART 1 of 4

**A:** The Scrutinies are very special rites that are celebrated on the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent, at liturgies where the elect (those preparing for Baptism) are present.

Part of their journey to the font (Baptismal pool) is that they have been received among us at the Rite of Acceptance. The Rite of Acceptance is an ancient rite that recognizes the Catechumen's decision to begin the process of becoming a member of the Catholic Church through Baptism and welcomes the Candidate, those who have been baptized in another faith or baptized Catholic as a child, but not instructed in the faith, into the process of full communion with the Church.

The names of the Catechumens are enrolled in the Book of the Elect. The Book of the Elect is a formal record of the names of those from the parish who have been elected for Baptism. This book is taken to the cathedral and presented to the Bishop at the Rite of Election. The Rite of Election and enrollment of names closes the period of the catechumenate. This last step is called election because the acceptance made by the Church is founded on the election by God, in whose name the Church acts. This step is also called the enrollment of names because as a pledge of fidelity, the candidates inscribe their names in the book that lists those who have been chosen for Baptism. These are ancient rites and profoundly rooted in our human experience. To be continued... —*From the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy, NCCB*

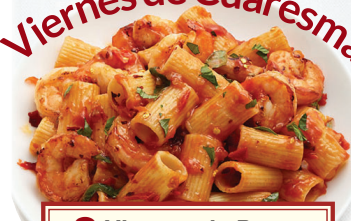

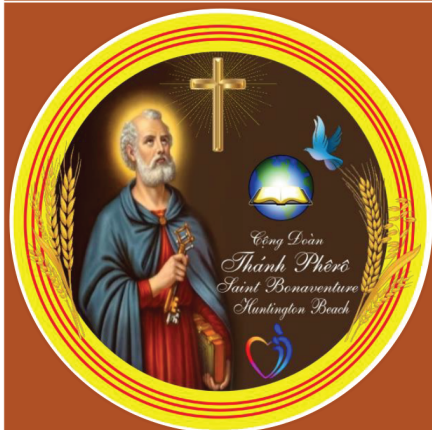

## CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN II MÙA CHAY NĂM B

**Phúc Âm: Mc 9, 1-9 "Đây là Con Ta rất yêu dấu"**

Kính thưa quý ông bà và anh chị em:

Một trong những câu hỏi mà tuần qua tôi hỏi các em học sinh bên trường học khi tới thăm các em là, "Tại sao người Công Giáo kiêng thịt vào các ngày thứ Sáu?" Dưới đây là một vài câu trả lời đầy thú vị:

\_Bởi vì chúng ta sẽ làm cho các động vật đau khi giết chúng để lấy thịt.

\_Bởi vì Chúa Giêsu không ăn thịt.

\_Bởi vì thịt thì mắc tiền hơn là cá.

\_Bởi vì ăn thịt thì lên cân nhiều hơn là ăn cá.

Câu trả lời chính xác là tại vì Chúa Giêsu chịu đóng đinh vào ngày thứ Sáu. Đoạn trích sau đây có thể giúp chúng ta hiểu rõ hơn, "Theo truyền thống thì từ thế kỷ thứ nhất, ngày Chúa Giêsu chịu đóng đinh được tuân giữ là ngày kiêng thịt ("black fast") để tôn vinh Ngài, Đấng đã hiến tế xác thịt của mình trong ngày thứ Sáu" (Klein, P., Catholic Source Book, 93).

Đó là lý do tại sao chúng ta kiêng thịt vào ngày thứ Sáu, đặc biệt là những ngày thứ Sáu trong Mùa Chay (Giáo Luật No 1251). Tuy nhiên vì nhận thấy việc kiêng thịt này có phần khó thực hiện, nên Hội Đồng Giám Mục Hoa Kỳ, vào năm 1966, đã cho phép các tín hữu có thể thực hiện một việc hy sinh nào tương xứng với việc kiêng thịt mà vẫn có thể duy trì được tâm tình sám hối (Bản Tuyên Bố Mục Vụ về Phép Hòa Giải và Kiêng Thịt, số 20). Các ngài nhắc nhở thêm, là mặc dù không còn mắc tội khi đã bỏ luật kiêng thịt, nhưng việc kiêng thịt vào những ngày thứ Sáu vẫn là điều trên hết (số 24). Lưu ý, bản tuyên bố này chỉ chuẩn cho những ngày thứ Sáu không thuộc Mùa Chay. Những ngày thứ Sáu trong Mùa Chay vẫn là những ngày buộc phải kiêng thịt.

Luật kiêng thịt sẽ trở thành phức tạp hơn khi chúng ta muốn biết thịt nào thì được phép ăn, còn thịt nào không được phép. Theo một bài viết của Cha Michael A. Van Sloun, "Why don't Catholics eat meat on Fridays?" thì thịt gà, bò, heo, hay nói chung là thịt của những động vật có máu nóng, chúng ta không được phép ăn, nhưng chúng ta được phép ăn những sản phẩm được chế biến từ những động vật này như bơ, sữa, trứng, vv.

Chúng ta được phép ăn những động vật thuộc loài máu lạnh như cá, tôm, cua, nghêu, sò, ốc, hến, vv. Những hải sản mắc tiền như tôm hùm và cua hoàng đế (king crab), chúng ta được phép ăn, nhưng vì đây là những món ăn xa xỉ, nên không thích hợp cho tinh thần hy sinh sám hối.

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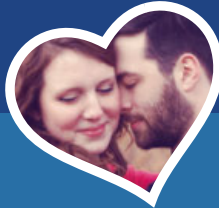
