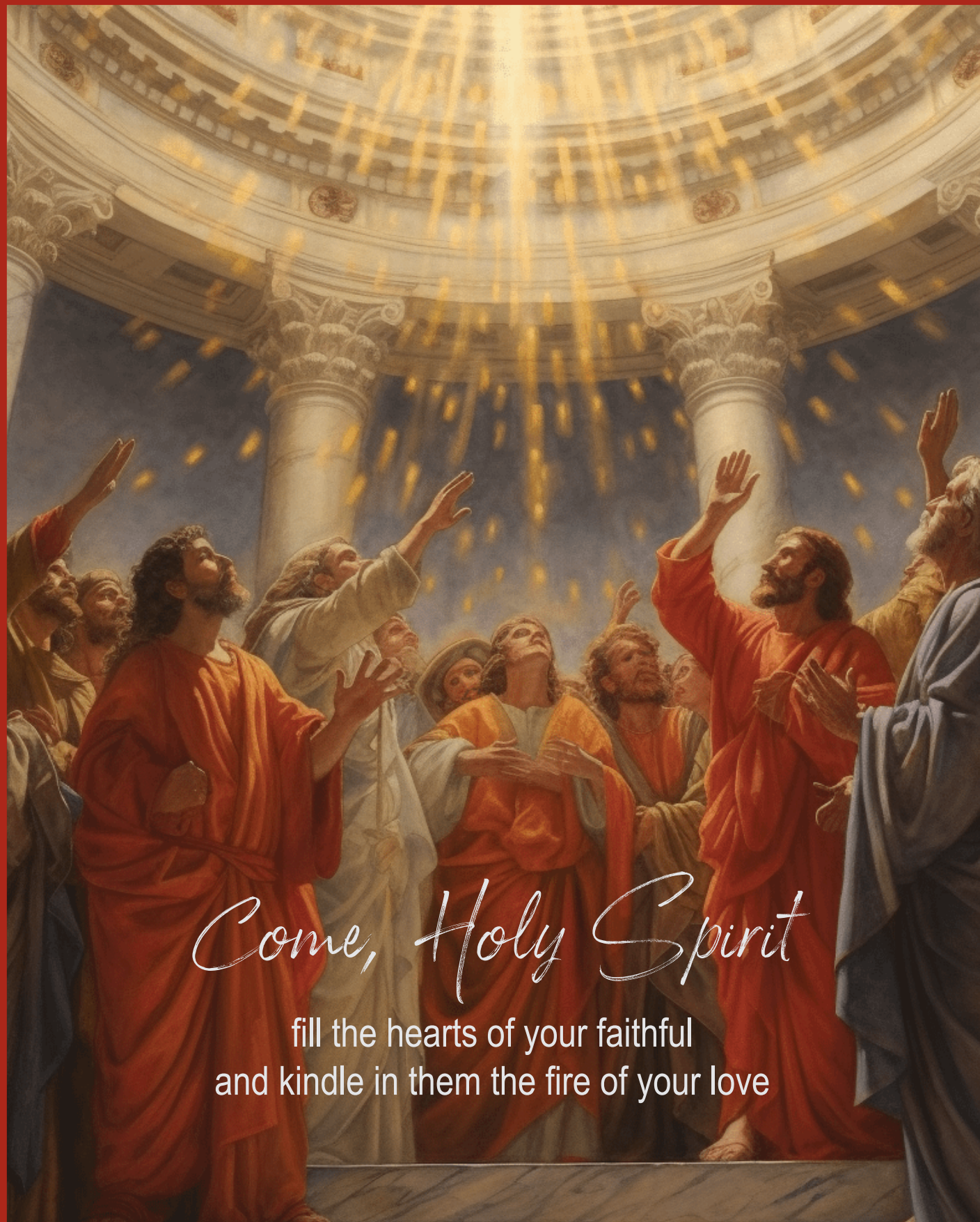

Pastor's Corner

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last Sunday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven, where he is seated at the right hand of the Father. This description of Jesus' seat sounds like a physical location in heaven, but St. Paul explains that Jesus' seat indicates His power and authority which are "far above every principality, authority, power, and dominion, and every name that is named not only in this age but also in the one to come" (Eph 1:21).

Following the Solemnity of the Ascension of Jesus is the Solemnity of the Pentecost, in which the Church celebrates the coming down of the Holy Spirit. In the Opening Prayer, we hear the Church praying for the outpouring of the gifts of the Holy Spirit to "sanctify your whole Church in every people and nation...across the face of the earth and, with the divine grace that was at work when the Gospel was first proclaimed, fill now once more the hearts of believers." Since the first Pentecost in the Church, in which the Holy Spirit came and rested as tongues of fire on each of the apostles (Acts 2:3), the Holy Spirit has never stopped working in the Church. The Third Person of the Holy Trinity continues to sanctify the Church by filling every heart of the faithful with His divine grace. Throughout the course of history, the Church might face persecutions and challenges, but without failing, the Holy Spirit has led her to a brighter future every time.

With the celebration of the Solemnity of the Pentecost, the Season of Easter comes to an end. The triple "Alleluia" we heard at the end of Mass on Easter Sunday and every Mass during the Octave of Easter joyfully opening the season, this triple "Alleluia" sounds again at the end of Mass this weekend to conclude the season. What a great season of grace that we were filled with. I hope you all feel the presence of God in your heart and mind and the working of the Holy Spirit in your words and deeds.

As the Easter Season is concluded, we enter the Season of the Ordinary Time. The word "Ordinary" has its root in the Latin word "ordo," which means "order, rank, class." In the language of liturgical calendar, "Ordinary" does not mean mediocre, regular, or dull, but it means the weeks from now until the end of the years will continue to be counted orderly in number. It will end with the 34th Sunday of the Ordinary Time, which is also the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

For whatever season we are in, we can always be assured of God's grace for us. He loves us and always has His way to remain in us.

I received my bachelor's degree from the University of California Los Angeles, and my masters' degrees from the California State University, Long Beach.

I am very happily married to my wife, Sarah, and we have a daughter, Elizabeth, who is almost 2 years old. We are currently pregnant with our second daughter who will be here before the end of the year! We are parishioners at Saint John Vianney Chapel in Newport Beach. 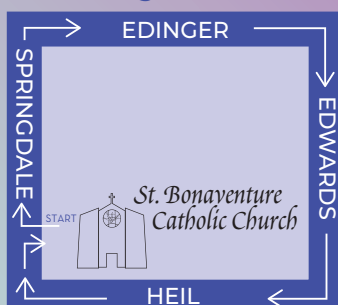


CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

Q&A

Q: Why do Catholics "confess" to a priest?

A: Part 2 of 2 – conclusion

The Church's role is to call us to humble repentance and to intercede and help us toward ongoing conversion. In so doing, the Church proclaims her faith in Christ's victory over sin, gives thanks to the Father for the freedom Christ has won for us, and offers her life as a spiritual sacrifice in praise of God's glory. Through the sacrament of confession (reconciliation), the Church calls all her children to be reconciled to God and to one another.

For the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be truly meaningful, three factors are essential: (a) a true sorrow for sin with the promise to amend, (b) the humble confession of sins and priestly absolution, and (c) being restored to fellowship with fellow Christians and the community.

Sin can be personal, as committed by the individual person, but always in relationship to others and the community; social as in negative moral attitudes affecting individuals and groups, and structural, as in economic, social or political patterns or systems that produce injustice and harm to people. We confess our wrongdoing in these different aspects or sin in order to be fully reconciled with God and our brothers and sisters.

Sin may be classified as mortal or "sin unto death," killing our basic love relationship with God and others. For a sin to be considered mortal, there must be a grave matter involved, sufficient knowledge and full consent. Venial sin is sin which does not involve our fundamental core freedom, but undermines and weakens our love relationship with God and others.

The major elements of the Sacrament of Reconciliation are: "contrition, confession and penance (satisfaction). The absolution granted by the priest of the sign of God's pardon, reconciling us to God and the faith community.

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN VII MÙA PHỤC SINH NĂM B

Ga 20, 19-23 "Như Cha đã sai Thầy, Thầy cũng sai các con: Các con hãy nhận lấy Thánh Thần".

Thưa quý ông bà và anh chị em:

Chúa Nhật tuần trước, chúng ta đã long trọng cử hành Lễ Chúa Giêsu Lên Trời và ngự bên hữu Thiên Chúa Cha. Nơi Chúa ngự được mô tả như một nơi chốn hữu hình ở trên trời, nhưng thực ra Thánh Phaolô giải thích rằng chỗ của Chúa biểu thị quyền năng và thẩm quyền của Ngài "vượt trên mọi cấp bậc các lãnh thần, quyền thần, dũng thần, và quản thần, vượt trên mọi danh hiệu được xưng hô cả đời này, lẫn đời sau." (Êphê-sô 1:21).

Sau Lễ Chúa Giêsu Lên Trời là Lễ Chúa Thánh Thần Hiện Xuống. Trong Lời nguyện nhập lễ, chúng ta nghe Giáo Hội cầu xin Chúa Thánh Thần tuôn đổ ân sủng để "thánh hóa toàn thể Giáo hội của Chúa nơi mọi dân tộc và quốc gia...trên khắp mặt đất và, với ân sủng thiêng liêng đã có từ khi Tin Mừng mới được rao truyền, bây giờ một lần nữa tràn đầy tâm hồn các tín hữu." Kể từ Lễ Ngũ Tuần đầu tiên trong Giáo Hội, khi Chúa Thánh Thần ngự đến và đậu như những lưỡi lửa trên mỗi tông đồ (Cv 2:3), Chúa Thánh Thần chưa bao giờ ngừng hoạt động trong Giáo Hội. Ngôi Ba Thiên Chúa tiếp tục thánh hóa Giáo Hội bằng cách ban cho các tín hữu tràn đầy ân sủng của Ngài. Trong suốt dòng lịch sử, Giáo Hội có thể phải đối phó với những cuộc bách hại và thử thách, nhưng chưa bao giờ bị đánh bại. Đức Chúa Thánh Thần luôn dẫn dắt Giáo Hội đến một tương lai tươi sáng hơn.

Lễ Đức Chúa Hiện Xuống cũng đã kết thúc lúc Mùa Phục Sinh. Mới hôm nào chúng ta nghe tiếng hát "Alleluia" ở cuối Thánh Lễ Chúa Nhật Phục Sinh, nay lại vang lên để kết thúc mùa Phục Sinh. Thật là một mùa ân sủng tuyệt vời đã đến với chúng ta. Tôi hy vọng quý ông bà và anh chị đều cảm nhận được sự hiện diện của Chúa trong tâm hồn của mình, cũng như sự hoạt động của Chúa Thánh Thần trong lời nói và việc làm của quý vị.

Mùa Phục Sinh qua đi, chúng ta bước vào Mùa Thường Niên. Từ "Thường Niên" có nguồn gốc từ tiếng Latin "ordo," có nghĩa là "thứ tự, cấp bậc, hay trình tự." Theo ngôn ngữ của lịch phụng vụ, "Thường Niên" không có nghĩa là tầm thường, đều đặn, hay buồn tẻ, mà có nghĩa là các tuần lễ từ nay cho đến hết năm sẽ được đếm theo số thứ tự. Nó sẽ kết thúc vào Chúa Nhật thứ 34 Thường Niên, cũng là Lễ Trọng kính Chúa Giêsu Kitô, Vua Vũ Trụ.

Dù đang ở trong bất cứ mùa phụng vụ nào, chúng ta có thể luôn yên tâm về ân sủng Thiên Chúa dành cho chúng ta. Ngài hằng yêu thương và luôn có cách để ở lại trong chúng ta.

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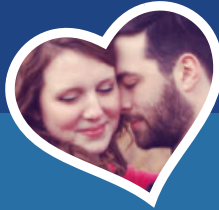
