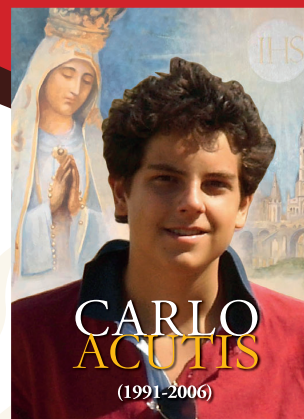

What is a Eucharistic Miracle?

Eucharistic miracles are extraordinary phenomena which manifest the Real Presence of Jesus in consecrated bread and wine, in a way that we can discern with ordinary senses. Each miracle is approved by the Catholic Church only after intense scientific scrutiny.

About the Exhibition

The Eucharistic Miracles Exhibition contains an extensive collection of photographs and records of Eucharistic miracles throughout the world and through history. The exhibit invites participants to deepen their understanding of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Who is Blessed Carlo Acutis?

A modern-day saint in the making, Blessed Carlo Acutis was an Italian teen known for his kindness, volunteer work with the poor, and his love of Christ. Carlo died of leukemia in 2006 at 15 years old and was beatified in 2020. During his short but extraordinary life, he was moved to promote love of Jesus through devotion to the Eucharist. He developed a website chronicling over 100 Eucharistic miracles. The website became a traveling exhibit making its way around the globe.

Pastor's Corner

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In February 2022, Pope Francis proclaimed 2025 as Jubilee Year under the title, "Pilgrims of Hope." In his letter of announcement, he states, "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us, and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision. The forthcoming Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we so urgently desire" (<https://press.vatican.va/>).

What is the Jubilee Year? The Jubilee Year has its root in the Book of Leviticus, which says, "You shall treat this fiftieth year as sacred. You shall proclaim liberty in the land for all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, when each of you shall return to your own property, each of you to your own family" (25:10). The 50th year is the Jubilee Year or the Sabbatical Year. During this year, slaves would be set free, debt be forgiven, and even the land be allowed to rest.

Recognizing the practice of the Jubilee year can be a great spiritual benefit for the Church, Pope Boniface VII proclaimed the first Jubilee in 1300. This practice of 50 years lasted almost two centuries until Pope Paul II decided to reduce it in 1470 to 25 years as it is now. The reason is 50 years is a long time, and many people only get to celebrate once in their lifetime. From a document in the Church, the Jubilee year is described as follows:

It is a year of forgiveness of sins and also the punishment due to sin, it is a year of reconciliation between adversaries, of conversion and receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and consequently of solidarity, hope, justice, commitment to serve God with joy and in peace with our brothers and sisters. A Jubilee year is above all the year of Christ, who brings life and grace to humanity (https://www.vatican.va/jubilee_2000/docs/).

To prepare for the Jubilee Year 2025, Pope Francis has designated 2024 as a year of prayer. This initiative was unveiled in his speech on January 21, 2024, stating, "From now on I am happy to think that the year preceding the Jubilee event, 2024, will be dedicated to a great 'symphony' of prayer so as to rediscover the desire to be in the presence of the Lord, to listen to him and adore Him."

To respond to the Holy Father's desire, Bishop Vann invites each parish in the Diocese of Orange to recite the Jubilee Prayer, written by Pope Francis himself. So beginning Monday, June 3rd, our parish will recite this prayer before every Mass to prepare ourselves for the Jubilee Year.

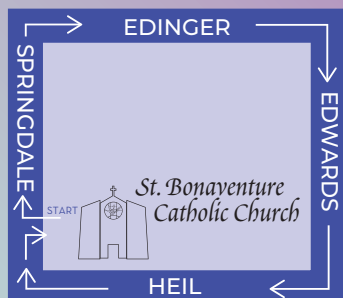


CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

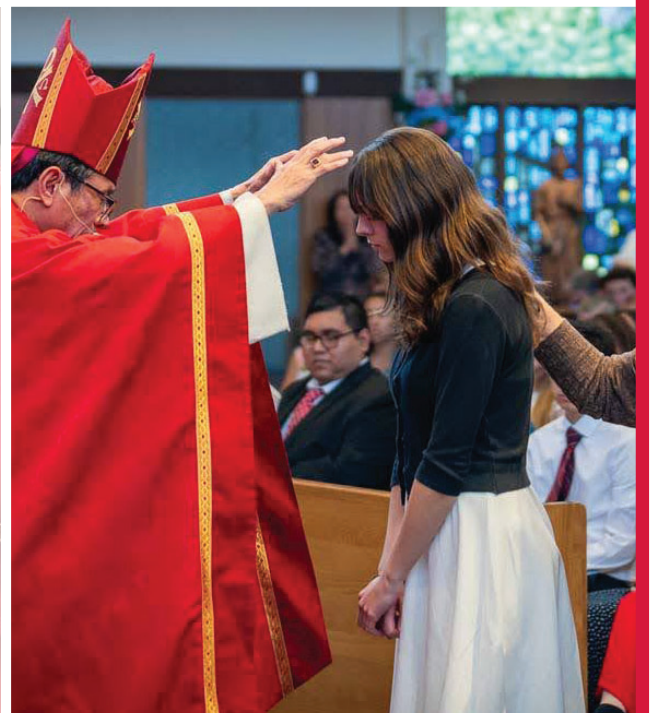

MARY'S PATH

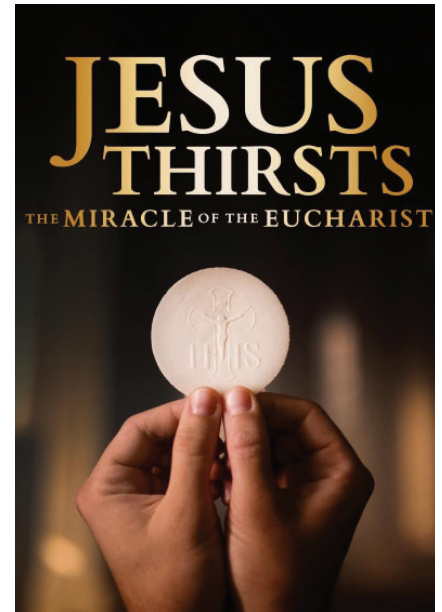
Guest Speaker June 20

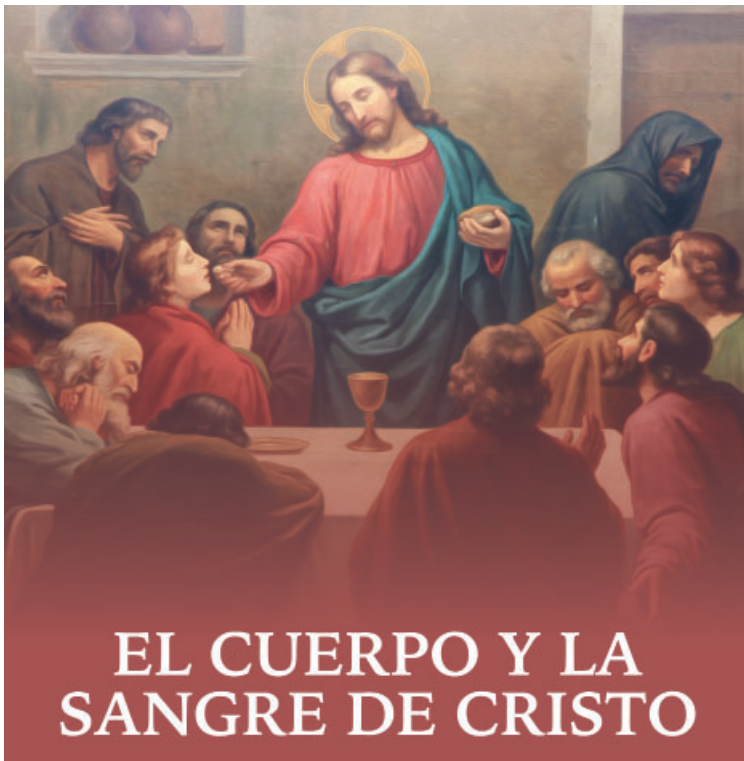

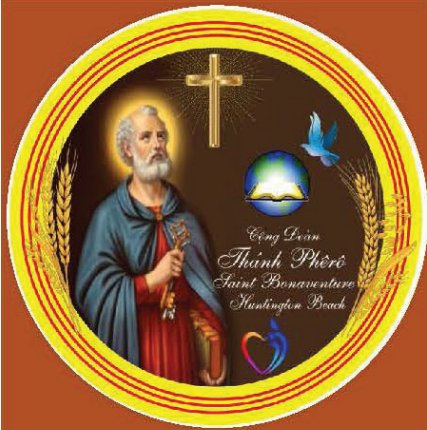

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN IX MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM B Mc 14, 12-16. 22-26 "Đây là Mình Ta. Đây là Máu Ta".

Thưa quý ông bà và anh chị em:

Vào tháng 2 năm 2022, Đức Thánh Cha Phanxicô đã công bố năm 2025 là Năm Thánh với chủ đề "Những Người Lữ Hành của Niềm Hy Vọng." Trong thư thông báo, ngài nói: "Chúng ta phải làm bùng sáng ngọn lửa hy vọng đã được trao cho chúng ta, và giúp mọi người có được sức mạnh và lòng tin tưởng mới bằng cách nhìn về tương lai với tinh thần cởi mở, một trái tim thành tín và tầm nhìn xa trông rộng. Năm Thánh sắp tới có thể góp phần rất lớn vào việc khôi phục bầu không khí hy vọng và tin cậy như một khúc dạo đầu cho sự đổi mới và tái sinh mà chúng ta vô cùng mong muốn" (<https://press.vatican.va/>).

Năm Thánh là gì? Năm Thánh có nguồn gốc từ Sách Lêvi, được ghi lại như sau: "Người hãy làm cho năm thứ năm mươi nên năm thánh và hãy kể là năm tha tội cho mọi người cư ngụ trong nước người, vì đó là năm toàn xá. Người ta sẽ làm chủ lại cơ nghiệp mình, và ai nấy đều được trở về gia đình cũ của mình." (25:10). Năm thứ 50 là Năm Thánh hay còn được gọi là Năm Sabbat. Trong năm này, nô lệ sẽ được trả tự do, nợ được tha, và ngay cả đất đai cũng được nghỉ ngơi.

hận thấy Năm Thánh có thể đem lại nhiều lợi ích thiêng liêng quý báu cho Giáo Hội, Đức Giáo Hoàng Bênêđictô XVI đã công bố Năm Thánh đầu tiên vào năm 1300. Việc thực hành Năm Thánh này kéo dài gần hai thế kỷ cho đến năm 1470, khi Đức Giáo Hoàng Phaolô II quyết định giảm xuống còn 25 năm như hiện nay. Lý do là 50 năm là một khoảng thời gian dài, và nhiều người chỉ có thể mừng được một lần trong đời. Từ một tài liệu trong Giáo Hội, Năm Thánh được mô tả như sau:

Đó là năm tha thứ tội lỗi và những hình phạt do tội gây ra. Năm Thánh là năm hòa giải giữa những kẻ thù địch, năm hoán cải và lãnh nhận Bí Tích Hòa Giải, và do đó là năm của liên đới, hy vọng, công bằng, dẫn thân phục vụ Thiên Chúa với niềm vui và trong an bình với anh chị em của chúng ta. Năm Thánh trên hết là năm của Chúa Kitô, Đấng mang lại sự sống và ân sủng cho nhân loại (https://www.vatican.va/jubilee_2000/docs/).

Để chuẩn bị cho Năm Thánh 2025, Đức Thánh Cha Phanxicô đã chọn năm 2024 là năm cầu nguyện. Ý tưởng này đã được công bố trong bài phát biểu của ngài vào ngày 21 tháng 1 năm 2024: "Từ bây giờ trở đi, tôi vui mừng mỗi khi nghĩ rằng năm 2024, một năm trước Năm Thánh, sẽ được dành riêng như một 'bản giao hưởng' cầu nguyện vĩ đại để tái khám phá mong muốn được hiện diện trước nhan thánh Chúa, lắng nghe Ngài và tôn thờ Ngài."

Để đáp lại ước nguyện của Đức Thánh Cha, Đức Cha Vann mời gọi mỗi giáo xứ trong Giáo Phận Orange đọc Kinh Năm Thánh do chính Đức Thánh Cha Phanxicô viết. Vì vậy, bắt đầu từ thứ Hai, ngày 3 tháng 6, giáo xứ chúng ta sẽ đọc kinh này trước mỗi Thánh Lễ để chuẩn bị cho Năm Thánh 2025.

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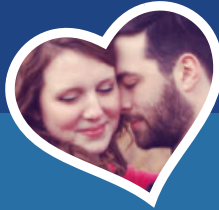
