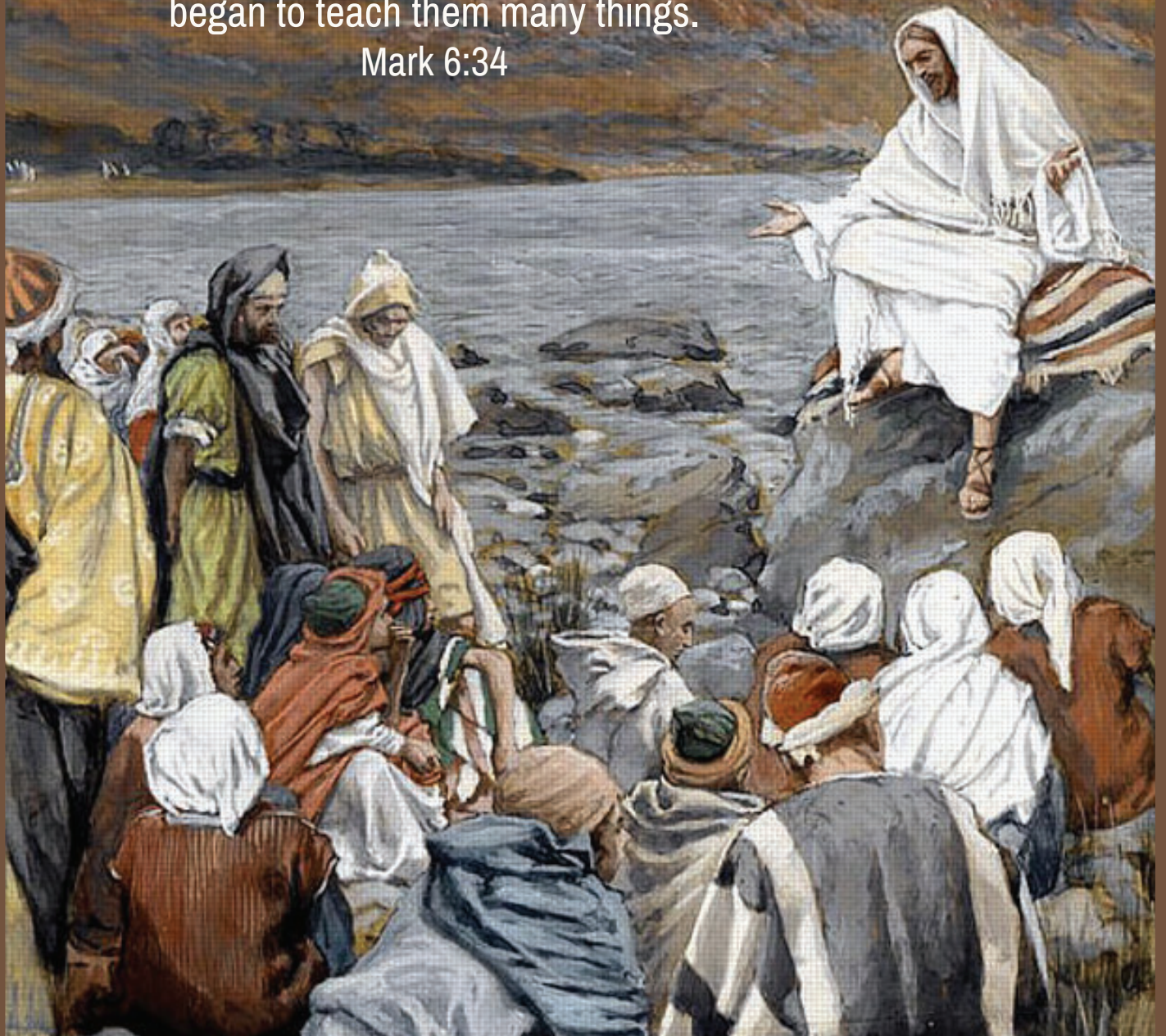

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Every year, our parish joyfully celebrates our patron, St. Bonaventure, whose feast day is July 15. This year, because it fell on a Monday, we celebrated on the Friday before, so more people could participate. We started with a trilingual Mass at 6:00 p.m. attended by about 400 people. After Mass, a reception followed in the parish hall to recognize and honor all our volunteers who have contributed their talents and time to the parish community, which no amount of money can buy.

We all enjoyed the food, drinks, and especially the fellowship. Many people expressed their joy to be part of the celebration. In grateful spirit, I would like to thank all who helped in this celebration, especially the Pastoral Council for coordinating it. The feast of St. Bonaventure will be our annual celebration. We will celebrate it on either the Friday before or the Friday after. For 2025, it will be on July 18. Please save the date.

As I shared with you in my last Pastor's Corner, Fr. Saúl and I are now the only two priests for the parish. I need to evaluate our ministries to see how we can best serve the parish, and at the same time, to ensure good health for both of us. I have talked to our four deacons, staff and different councils. Their recommendation is not to add any more ministry to what we already provide and to discontinue the 8:00 p.m. Saturday confessions.

This late confession time has been a challenge for me since I got here, and with two priests would be even more difficult. Saturday is a very busy day, which is a good sign for an active parish. There are Masses, Baptisms, weddings, funerals and quinceañeras. Moreover on Saturday, we offer confessions three times a day in the morning, afternoon and evening; many churches in our diocese offer only one.

So, beginning August, we will continue to have confessions at 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. every Saturday, but the late confession at 8:00 p.m. will be discontinued. We will announce this change in church and in the bulletin. I ask you to let one another know about it.

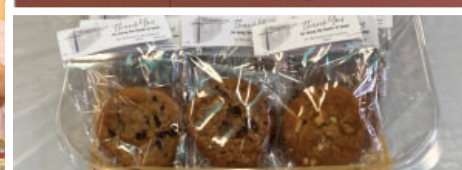

Radiate Love

Natural Family Planning: Supporting God's Gifts of Love and Life in Marriage

In NFP both husband and wife are taught to understand and live God's design for married love—this will give them countless blessings! NFP methods promote a holistic approach to family planning which both respects procreation and has the potential to deepen the intimacy of husband and wife. NFP methods support reproductive health. They are good for the body. For the woman, NFP charting can even assist in the diagnosis of underlying medical problems. And, if a couple find they are having trouble conceiving, NFP information can help them pinpoint the most fertile time of the wife's cycle. The natural methods have none of the harmful side effects caused by contraception, especially chemical contraceptives (e.g. pill, injection, etc.). NFP methods can be marriage strengthening because it relies on couple communication and behavior change. When living the NFP lifestyle, husband and wife learn that they have a shared responsibility for safeguarding God's gift of human sexuality, marriage and family. They also grow in their understanding of God's will for their family size. NFP has the potential to make a good marriage great!"—rcbo.org/ministry/office-for-family-life

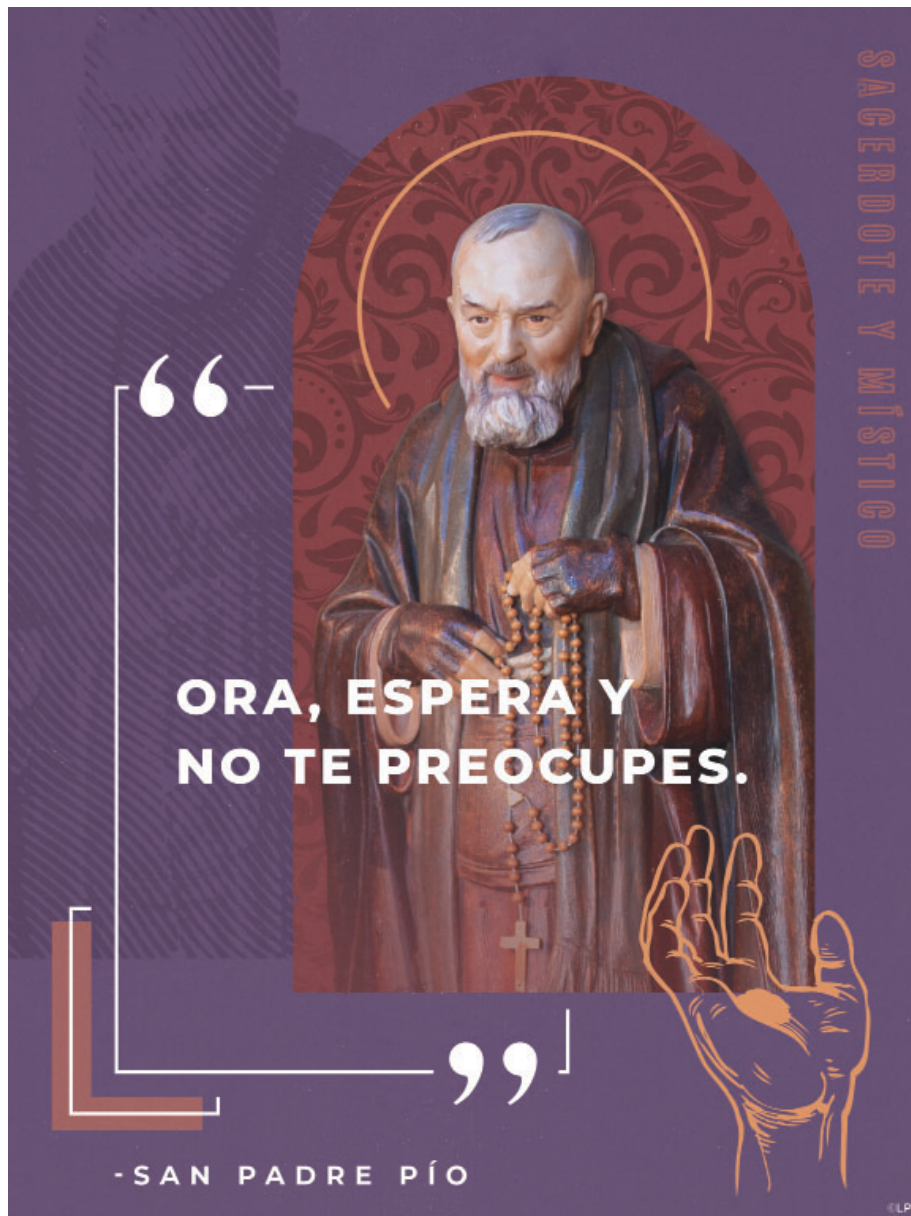

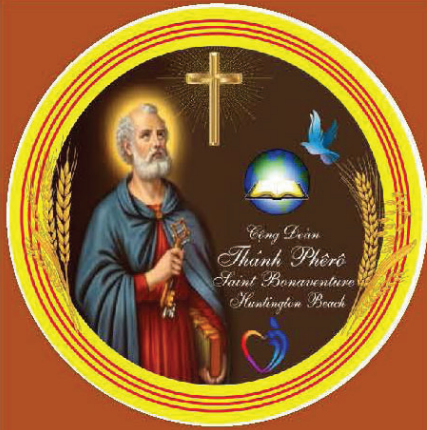

Thưa quý ông bà và anh chị em:

Hàng năm, chúng ta hân hoan mừng kính thánh bốn mạng Bonaventura, quan thầy của giáo xứ, có ngày lễ kính là ngày 15 tháng 7. Năm nay, vì ngày lễ kính rơi vào ngày thứ Hai nên chúng ta đã mừng vào ngày thứ Sáu trước đó, để nhiều người có thể tham gia hơn. Chương trình bắt đầu với Thánh Lễ ba ngôn ngữ vào lúc 6 giờ chiều, và có khoảng 400 người tham dự. Sau Thánh lễ, có tiệc mừng tại hội trường để tri ân tất cả các tình nguyện viên đã đóng góp tài năng và thời gian của mình cho giáo xứ mà không hề quản ngại. Mọi người ăn uống và hàn huyên vui vẻ. Trong tinh thần tri ân, tôi chân thành cảm ơn tất cả những ai đã phục vụ trong Thánh Lễ và buổi tiệc, đặc biệt là Hội Đồng Mục Vụ đã điều hành cách tốt đẹp. Lễ Thánh Bonaventura sẽ được mừng hàng năm vào ngày thứ Sáu trước hoặc sau ngày 15 tháng 7, trước là kính thánh bốn mạng giáo xứ, sau là tri ân các anh chị em thiện nguyện viên. Sang năm 2025, chúng ta sẽ mừng vào ngày thứ Sáu, 18 tháng 7. Xin quý ông bà và anh chị em vui lòng ghi số.

Như tôi đã chia sẻ trong bản thông tin tuần trước rằng giáo xứ hiện nay chỉ còn lại có hai linh mục là Cha Saul và tôi, vậy tôi cần phải xem xét lại các mục vụ trong giáo xứ để chúng tôi có thể phục vụ cách tốt nhất, đồng thời đảm bảo sức khỏe tốt cho cả hai chúng tôi. Tôi đã nói chuyện với bốn thầy phó tế, các nhân viên, và các hội đoàn, đoàn thể, và đề nghị của họ là không mở thêm bất kỳ mục vụ nào nữa và khép lại giờ giải tội lúc 8 giờ tối thứ Bảy.

Giờ giải tội vào lúc 8:00 tối thứ Bảy luôn là một thách đố đối với tôi kể từ khi về đây và bây giờ lại càng khó khăn hơn. Vào mỗi cuối tuần, thứ Bảy là một ngày rất bận rộn. Thực ra đây là một dấu hiệu tốt cho một giáo xứ đang sinh hoạt sống động. Từ 8:00 sáng đến 9:30 tối, chúng ta liên tục có các Lễ, rửa tội, đám cưới, đám tang, lễ quinceañera và giải tội. Đến cuối ngày, tôi không chỉ mệt vì kiệt sức mà còn đói nữa, vì không có thời gian để ăn. Nhiều nhà thờ trong giáo phận chỉ có một buổi xưng tội, còn chúng ta có đến ba buổi.

Tôi không có ý tỏ ra than vãn, nhưng điều quan trọng là cần phải lo cho sức khỏe tốt để có thể phục vụ lâu dài. Vì lý do này, bắt đầu từ tháng 8, giáo xứ vẫn tiếp tục có giải tội vào lúc 8:30 sáng và 3:30 chiều thứ Bảy hàng tuần, nhưng giờ giải tội vào lúc 8:00 tối sẽ không tiếp tục nữa. Chúng tôi sẽ cho thông báo trong nhà thờ và trên tờ thông tin của giáo xứ. Anh chị em vui lòng nhắc nhở nhau.

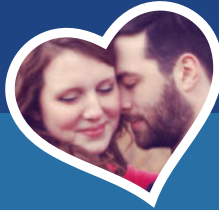
