Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It is part of our daily routine that we are making decisions about trivial matters like, "What shall I have for breakfast" to important matters of faith like, "Shall I take my family to church this Sunday?" Decision-making is part of our life, and righteous decisions will make us rational human beings in a desirable relationship with God.

Today's readings are filled with examples of decision making. In the first reading, we heard about God, who chose to deliver his people, the Israelites, from the land of slavery to the promised land. In response, Joshua, who was Moses' successor, told the people about his decision, "As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD." The people as well answered, "We also will serve the LORD, for he is our God." To serve God is to believe in him and to be faithful to him.

Moving on to the Gospel, after six consecutive Sundays, this Sunday we come to the final passage of St. John's chapter 6, which begins with the miracle of multiplication. From this miracle, Jesus revealed to the crowds his decision, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." Jesus' decision to be the living bread gives us eternal life. In response to his decision, Jesus wants us to choose whether we accept to gnaw on his flesh or refuse it just like he asks his disciples, "Do you also want to leave?"

As your children are going back to school, I would like to invite you to register them for our confirmation program or religious education. I hope your decision will be like that of Peter when he responded to Jesus, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." Your faith in God will help your children to learn about the same faith leading them to receiving the sacraments.

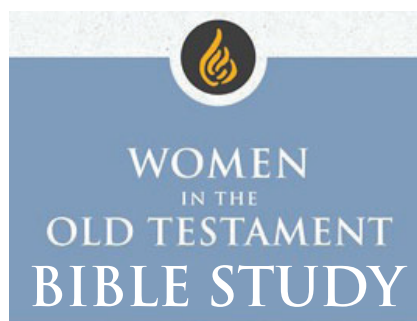

Q&A **Q: What is meant by "Charisms"?**

A: Charisms or Charismata is from the Greek word *Charisma*{ta} which means favors or benefits. These are the terms used by St. Paul when he refers to the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, 1 Corinthians 12:4-26. He describes them as extraordinary, supernatural and transitory. These Gifts are given directly for the common good, which is the spiritual welfare of the Christian Community.

The Gifts are special. They are directed toward service to the Lord and manifest the work of God through the Holy Spirit. The Gifts include many behaviors, but most especially a knowledge of God. This is because the Gifts always point back to God. The various Gifts include Charism of Administration (the gifts for shepherding God's people). Knowledge (the gifts of the mind, ability to instruct others in the faith), Prayer (the gifts of communing with God) and Service (which builds up the Church)."

The *New Catechism* states "whatever their character – sometimes it is extraordinary, (such as the gift of miracles or the gift of tongues) charisms are oriented toward sanctifying grace and are intended for the common good of the Church. Further, "the Holy Spirit ... working in many ways, by special graces ... makes the faithful 'fit and ready' to undertake various tasks and offices for the renewal and the building up of the church."

The *Catechism* further states "Charisms are to be accepted with gratitude by the persons who receive them and by all members of the Church as well. They are a wonderfully rich grace for the apostolic vitality and for the holiness of the entire Body of Christ ... provided they are genuine gifts of the Holy Spirit and used in full conformity with the authentic promptings of this same Spirit.

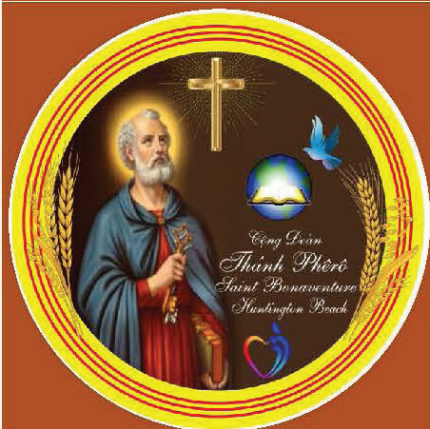

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXI MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM B

Phúc Âm: Ga 6, 61-70

"Chúng con sẽ đi đến với ai? Thầy mới có những lời ban sự sống".

Anh chị em thân mến:

Hàng ngày chúng ta thường có những quyết định từ những vấn đề lật vạt như, "Tôi sẽ ăn gì trong buổi sáng ngày hôm nay," cho đến những vấn đề quan trọng trong đức tin như, "Chúa Nhật này tôi có nên đưa cả gia đình đi Lễ không?" Việc đưa ra quyết định là một phần không thể tránh khỏi ở trong cuộc sống, và những quyết định đúng đắn sẽ giúp chúng ta trở thành những con người đầy lý trí trong mối tương quan tốt đẹp với Thiên Chúa.

Các bài đọc hôm nay cho chúng ta thấy có nhiều quyết định từ Thiên Chúa và con người. Bài đọc một trình thuật cuộc xuất hành với quyết định của Thiên Chúa muốn giải thoát dân Người khỏi cảnh nô lệ và đưa họ đến vùng đất hứa. Để đáp lại, Joshua, người kế vị Mosê, nói với dân chúng về quyết định của mình: "Phần tôi và gia đình tôi, chúng tôi sẽ tôn thờ Chúa." Dân chúng cũng trả lời rằng: "Về phần chúng tôi, chúng tôi sẽ phụng thờ Chúa, vì Người là Thiên Chúa của chúng tôi."

Sang đến bài Phúc Âm, đoạn Tin Mừng ngày hôm nay, sau bốn Chúa Nhật liên tiếp, kết thúc chương 6 của Phúc Âm Thánh Gioan. Từ phép lạ hóa bánh ra nhiều, Chúa Giêsu đã mạc khải cho đám đông dân chúng biết quyết định của Ngài là muốn trở nên "bánh hằng sống từ trời xuống... để cho thế gian được sống." Để đáp lại ý định của Người, Chúa Giêsu muốn chúng ta hãy chọn xem mình muốn chấp nhận ăn "Thịt" của Người hay từ chối. Ngài hỏi các môn đệ, "Các ngươi cũng muốn bỏ đi sao?"

Trong thời gian này các em đang trở lại trường, tôi muốn mời gọi quý vị phụ huynh hãy ghi danh cho các em học giáo lý và Việt Ngữ. Tôi cầu mong là quyết định của quý vị sẽ được giống như quyết định của Thánh Phêrô khi ngài thưa với Chúa Giêsu, "Lạy Thầy, chúng con sẽ đi theo ai? Thầy mới có những lời ban sự sống đời đời. Phần chúng con, chúng con tin và chúng con biết rằng: Thầy là Đấng Kitô Con Thiên Chúa." Nhờ vào đâu mà chúng ta có được đức tin ngày hôm nay? Phần lớn là nhờ vào ông bà cha mẹ đã giáo dục chúng ta. Vậy giờ đây, đến lượt mình, chúng ta hãy giúp các em học hỏi về cùng một đức tin vào Thiên Chúa để các em có thể lãnh nhận các bí tích.

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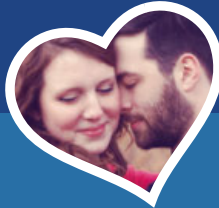

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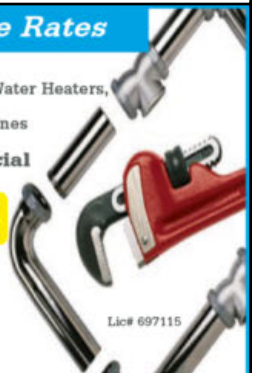
