Altar Server Agreement

We understand the commitment to be an altar server means serving at a variety of liturgical celebrations. This includes Sunday Mass as indicated previously, along with potentially:

- 8:30 am Mass For SBS Students on SBS School Days
- 8:00 am Mass on Saturdays for all servers (~once every 3 months) (*not in 2023-4*)
- 8:30 am daily Mass and 8 am Saturday Mass during Christmas, Easter, and Summer Vacations. (*not in 2023-4*)
- 6 pm Fridays during Lent for Stations of the Cross
- Holy Day of Obligation Masses as announced
- Special Masses or services as announced (Confirmation, Christmas, Easter, Holy Thursday, Good Friday)

We also understand that there will be training sessions scheduled during the course of the Altar Server year and that depending on our experience level we will be required to attend one or more of these sessions.

We understand that if we are unable to serve at a scheduled mass that it is our responsibility to find a substitute.

We commit to this ministry freely. We understand its impact on our family schedule. We promise to help our Altar Server follow the guidelines and expectations as given in the training packet, and meet his/her obligations responsibly.

Altar Server Dress Code Agreement

Boys

Shoes: Black Dress Shoes with socks. No flip-flops, tennis shoes, sandals or other casual shoes.

Pants: Khaki, navy or black dress or casual long pants. No jeans of any color, no shorts.

Shirts: Collared shirts only. (e.g. polo shirts, button down shirts.) No T-shirts.

Hair: Color should not be shocking or attention getting. If you wear your hair long it needs to be tied back off of your face to ensure safety while carrying candles.

Girls

Shoes: Dressy shoes, black or another dark colored is preferred (ballet type flats are fine). No platform shoes, flip-flops, tennis shoes, clog type shoes or high heels are to be worn.

Pants: Casual or dress pants, knee length or longer skirt or dress. Blue jeans and shorts are not to be worn.

Shirts: casual top/blouse. No tank tops, bare midriffs, or bare shoulders.

Hair: Color should not be shocking or attention getting. Long hair must be tied back to ensure safety while carrying candles. Hair that is shorter than shoulder length should be held back with a hairband.

Make-up, accessories and nails: No excessive jewelry or make-up. Nail polish may not be dark or bright colors.

We understand that attire and appearance are important when serving. We have read the guidelines above and will follow them.
